

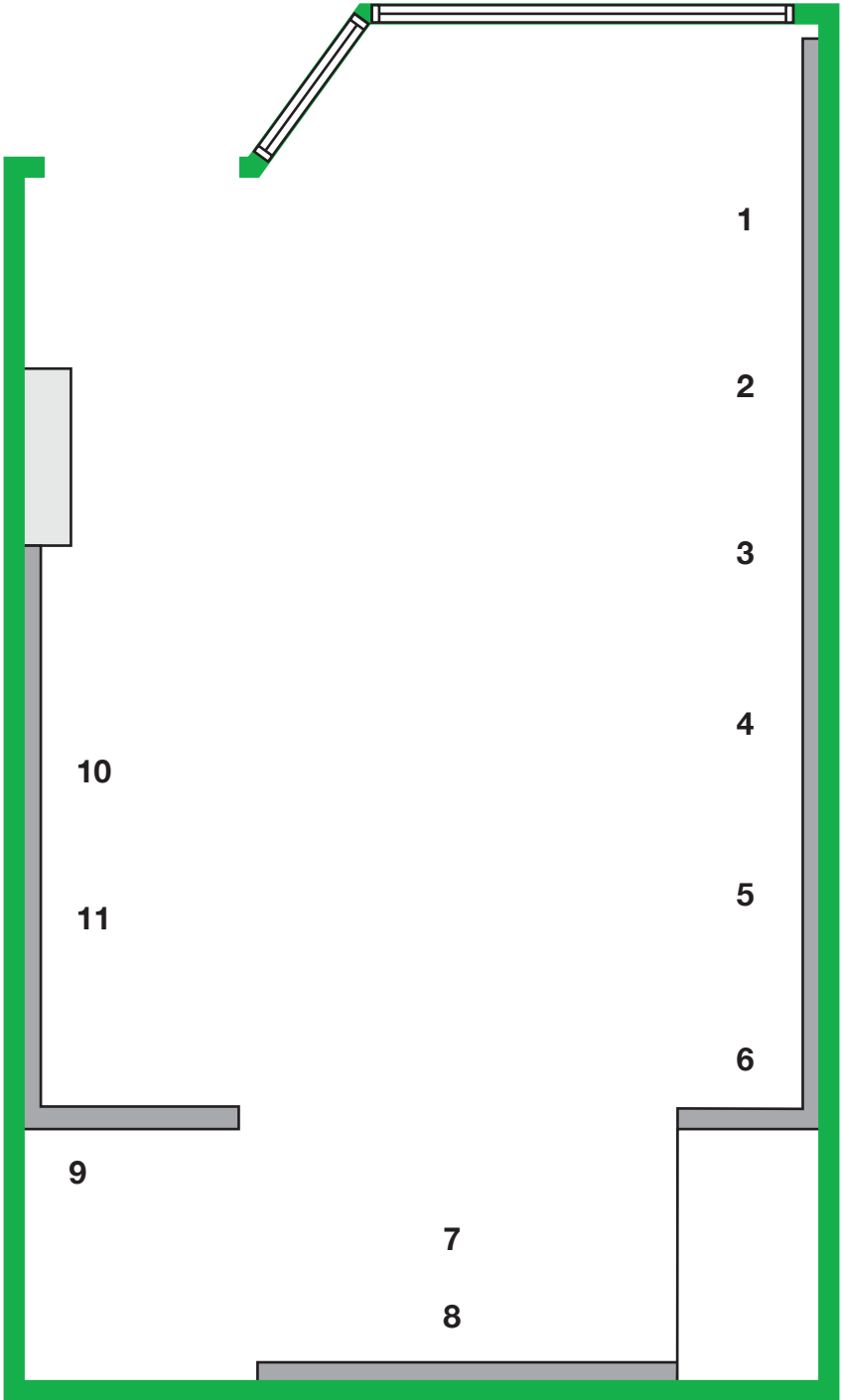


Bed & Breakfast
