## **SPCE Gallery Presents *Thingamajig***

SPCE Gallery is pleased to present *Thingamajig*, a group exhibition featuring the works of Joshua Abelow, Patrick David, Elly Kalantari, and Carrie R. The exhibition opens on May 10th with a reception from 5-8 PM and will be on view through June 15th. *Thingamajig* brings together four artists whose distinct practices engage with abstraction, materiality, and cultural narratives to explore the interplay between form and meaning.

The concept of *Thingamajig* revolves around the idea of gobbledygook and rigamarole—expressions of confusion, excess, or nonsensical intricacy. The term itself, like its counterparts *thingamabob*, *whatchamacallit*, and *doohickey*, refers to an object or idea whose name is forgotten, unknown, or intentionally left ambiguous. Through playful material experimentation, enigmatic compositions, and layered narratives, the exhibition questions the way meaning is constructed, dissolved, or substituted in contemporary visual language.

### **Featured Artists:**

Joshua Abelow employs bold colors, geometric abstraction, and text-based elements to create witty, self-referential paintings. Patrick David's drawings on paper tell stories like poems, leaving trails of evidence without a query. Elly Kalantari crafts intricate mixed-media sculptures that explore transformation and selfhood, reimagining forms and gestures. Carrie R works in sculpture, layering biotic narratives and cinematic mythologies to challenge physical spaces.

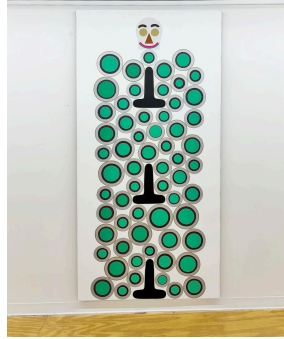
### **Exhibition Information:**

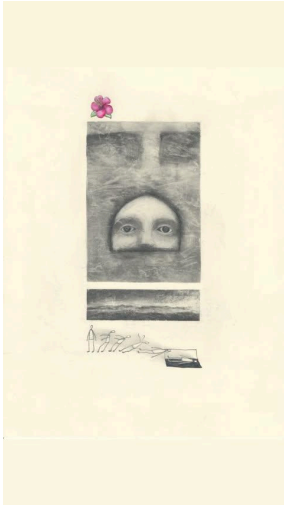

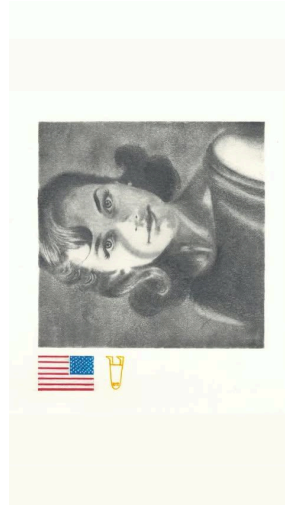

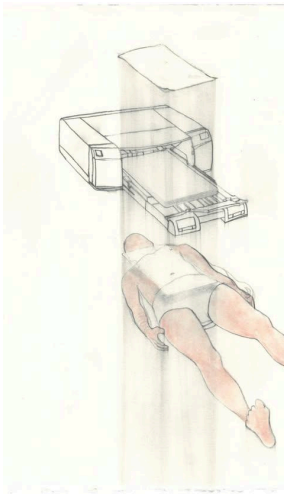

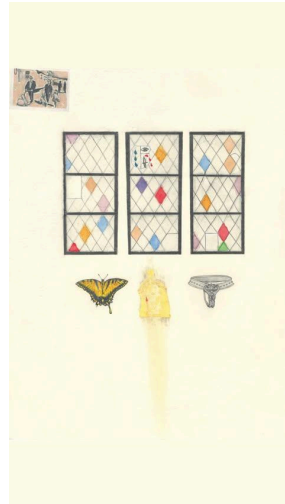

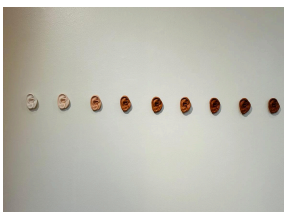
