ABOUT THE ARTIST

Andrew Mai Osborne is an American singer/songwriter whose work explores memory, inheritance, and the human spirit. Born in Emporia, Kansas and based in Easton, Pennsylvania, Mai Osborne crafts soundscapes that move between intimacy and vastness, drawing from folk traditions, ambient composition, and cinematic storytelling.

Rooted in lineage and belonging, his work traces the terrain between what is kept, what is lost, and what must be reckoned with. Whether producing under his independent imprint, Copacetic Records, or performing his own material on stage, Mai Osborne treats music as both witness and meditation.



PROJECT FEATURE: Portrait of a Future Ancestor

Portrait of a Future Ancestor is a solo album by American singer/songwriter Andrew Mai Osborne, performed in 2025 in Pennsylvania and released on Copacetic Records the following year. Across twelve tracks, Mai Osborne weaves grief, memory, and ancestral echoes into intimate confessions and layered harmonies, moving between folk, indie rock, and electronic textures. This album meditates what we carry forward, what we leave behind, and how music transforms loss into legacy.

“This album became a space to remember and reimagine myself – to hold both grief and growth. It taught me that legacy isn’t what we leave behind, but how we continue to show up: for ourselves, for each other, and for what’s still possible.”


