Sarah's mouth falls open, her eyes widen in shock.

SARAH

Oh. My. God. Oh my god! Are you okay? What happened?

MAGGIE

Oh, I'm okay, I think.
(she chuckles, trying to
make herself feel better)
(MORE)

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

We just realized it wasn't working. It's tough, but I know it's for the best and you know, we'll always care about each other, eventually maybe we'll even be friends.

(she laughs, but it obviously stings)

We were just growing a part, not together and you know, made the "adult" and smart decision to break up.

SARAH

Oh my god. He cheated. That's what it was, wasn't it?!

MAGGIE

No, not at-

SARAH

I can't believe it. I can't believe he cheated on you. Wow. You know I thought you two were going to get married.

Maggie strains a smile.

MAGGIE

Thanks? But, look he didn't -

SARAH

And then that piece of shit goes and cheats on you. Men our scum, Maggie. Except for David of course, but the rest of them, oh my god! I thought you would be engaged by the end of the year!

MAGGIE

Okay? I think you're not-

SARAH

I mean I even imagined what your wedding would be like. I figured we would be invited. And I know this sounds crazy, but I started a pinterest board for it. I can't believe he cheated! You must be devastated, like crying everyday devastated.

SARAH (CONT'D)

Maggie slowly puts her headphones back in. Sarah is oblivious.

SARAH (CONT'D)

You know I literally just read a Buzzfeed article about cheaters and how there are so many signs. Were there signs? Oh my God, I bet there were. There had to be. I can't believe there were so many signs.

Overlay of title: WE BROKE UP Day 5

CUT TO:

INT. OFFICE -DAY

Maggie is working on her computer. Her hair's been washed, but her eyes still look tired and she's hunching more than she should.

OVERLAY: Day 7

Two co-workers, LUCY and STACEY - twin-like best friends, finish each others sentences, dress almost identical and are attached at the hip - sit down at their desks and start snapping at Maggie to get her attention.

LUCY

Maggie!

STACEY

You are not going to believe what happen to us at lunch.

MAGGIE

What?

LUCY STACEY

Guess.

Guess.

MAGGIE

Did you see one of the Sprouse twins?

STACEY LUCY

Nope. Nope.

MAGGIE

Did you fall down at the same time again?

STACEY LUCY

Nope. Nope.

MAGGIE

Is it what happened last week when you both order the same salad, but didn't realize you did, until it came to the table and then you both screamed so loudly that the waiter dropped the salads and you never got to eat them?

Beat.

LUCY

We got hit on!

MAGGIE

Ah, my next guess.

STACEY

Maggie it was gross. They were all like "hey" and we were like-

LUCY

"Um hey", then they immediately asked for our numbers. It was nuts.

MAGGIE

Sounds it.

STACEY

You're so lucky you have a boyfriend.

Eek! That twinge hits Maggie again. But she's got to say it.

MAGGIE

(she sighs)

Actually, I've been meaning to mention. Brian and I broke up. Everything's okay, we ended as friends, but we're not together anymore.

Lucy and Stacey's mouths fall open. They look at Maggie, then at each other, then back at Maggie. Then they scream!

LUCY

Oh, my god, oh my god, oh my god. This is fate! I've never heard better news! Do you know what this means?!

STACEY

Oh, my god, oh my god, oh my god. I can't believe it. This is the greatest thing that's ever happened! Do you know what this means?!

MAGGIE

What?

STACEY

LUCY

We're all single! Together!! We're all single! Together!!

LUCY (CONT'D)

Okay, get your calendar out right now. We're going out and getting fucked.

STACEY

Yes! Please!

MAGGIE

Oh thanks, but I don't know if I'm ready for all that.

STACEY

Maggie, when I broke up with Dom, I fucked someone new immediately and that, is how I got HPV.

Beat. Maggies is extremely uncomfortable.

STACEY (CONT'D)

And of course over him, but I thought I should mention the HPV, like be careful.

LUCY

Look, Maggie. Do not question what a good fuck can do for you!

STACEY

Or even a bad fuck.

LUCY

Honestly, you just need to fuck.

MAGGIE

Please stop saying fuck.

They ignore her.

STACEY

This is going to be so great. We're the single table now! And we're going to be fuckinggggg!

LUCY

STACEY (CONT'D)

Aaahhh!

Aaaahhh!!

LUCY (CONT'D)

Let's get a sign.

STACEY

Let's get shirts! We'll have them say something about three's company or something.

LUCY

Yes! Men love groups of three.

STACEY

It reminds them of threesomes.

LUCY

And men love threesomes.

This cracks them up! Maggie strains a smile.

CUT TO:

## RESTAURANT - NIGHT

Maggie is sitting with a group of friends; LESLIE- a twenty something, self proclaimed comedian, but not very good- JOHN - mid twenties, bad dresser, loves drama- and CARA - 30, always looking for something to be mad about. They're laughing and talking.

Maggie looks a little better than before, she's laughing and the bags are starting to disappear. Her hunch is less and her outfit fits a lot better than the previous.

## Overlay: Day 10

LESLIE

So, then I was like but why is there beef in this? And he said (she can't stop laughing) He said-

JOHN

What did he say?!

LESLIE

He said, what beef?

She burst out laughing. Everyone just stares.

JOHN

That wasn't funny, Leslie.

Leslie rolls her eyes.

CARA

Hey, where's Brian, Maggie?

Maggie takes a deep breath in, these are her friends she should be able to tell them.

MAGGIE

Uh, I've been meaning to tell you all, but wasn't sure how, uh Brian and I, well, we broke up.

They stare at her in shock.

CARA

What?

MAGGIE

Yea, like a week ago. I think? It's been hard to talk about it, that's why I didn't mention it right away. I kind of just needed to be alone for awhile, let it sink in.

LESLIE

Is this a joke? Cause it's not funny.

They lean in like she's about to make a joke.

MAGGIE

No. Look, I know it might come as a shock, but we just realized we were growing a part and thought it would be best for both of us if we ended it.

They lean back, shaking their heads.

CARA

You broke up a week ago?

MAGGIE

Yes.

LESLIE

You broke up.

MAGGIE

Yes.

Maggie stares expectantly for their responses.

CARA

Why the fuck are we just hearing about this now?

JOHN

Seriously! What the fuck Maggie?

MAGGIE

Wait what?

CARA

I can't believe you waited this long to tell us.

JOHN

That's super fucked up Maggie.

MAGGIE

What?

CARA

Are we not like your best friends? Did you not even think about calling us?

MAGGIE

I'm sorry, it's honestly been pretty rough and I just needed to be alone with it. It was a big decision and one I wanted to make sure I felt good about before telling everyone.

They stare at her completely unmoved by what she just said.

LESLIE

We saw him yesterday and said hi. We had no idea we were supposed to hate him now. I even told him the beef joke! I look like an idiot.

JOHN

Yes, yes you do.

Leslie scoffs at John.

MAGGIE

I was still processing everything. Telling everyone means it's real and I guess I just wasn't ready for it to be.

Beat.

JOHN

That's super fucked up Maggie.

CARA

I hugged him when I saw him. How could you let me do that? Now he thinks I'm siding with him. And you know that I never side with the man. No wonder he looked at me weird!

MAGGIE

Why did you hug him?

CARA

Because I'm friendly! And he looked upset! Don't turn this around on me.

Maggie starts to say something, but The WAITER comes over and drops off more drinks. He looks at Maggie.

WAITER

You doing okay?

LESLIE

So, even the fucking waiter knows!!

Beat.

JOHN

That's super fucked up, Maggie.

CUT TO:

INT. BAR - NIGHT

MAX - 30ish, handsome in that hipsterish rugged way - is sitting in a booth with two beers in front of him. Maggie runs in.

They do a quick friendly hug and then take a seat across from each other in the booth. Maggie's hair is down, she's wearing some make-up and standing a little straighter.

## Overlay: Day 11

MAGGIE

Sorry I'm late. Trains were crazy.

MAX

Yea whatever.

(they both laugh)

How's it going?

MAGGIE

Can't complain. You?

MAX

Eh. Oh, I did finally get around to watching Castaway. Brian was right it did make me cry when the volleyball died.

Maggie knows she needs to tell Max, but doesn't want to make it weird.

MAGGIE

So just so you know, Brian and I actually broke up.

Beat.

Max just stares at her.

MAX

Huh.

Awkward silence. Maggie tries to make conversation.

MAGGIE

Is this an IPA?

Max nods, still in shock. He starts to look around uncomfortably and move his hands and arms over everything.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

Are you...

MAX

How long ago?

MAGGIE

A week or so, something like that.

MAX

Huh. I didn't...uh I didn't know that.

He continues to fidget around in the booth. He starts to move closer to her, but then moves back.

He keeps staring wide eyed at her, then looks away. He downs his beer. Then starts to get up, then decides not to.

MAGGIE

What's going on?

MAX

I don't want to be in a relationship.

MAGGIE

Um, okay?

MAX

I just don't want you to think this is a date. I mean it could be a date, I guess. I didn't know, I mean I definitely thought about it, but then was like no, and now I'm like duh! But I don't want a relationship.

MAGGIE

Neither do I. I just thought we could get a drink. We're friends. We've known each other for like 6 years, Max.

MAX

Right. But you're single now and I'm single. And I guess I've always thought you were cute, but like I'm not sure if this would work and I'm really not ready. So...okay?

Max is sweating.

MAGGIE

Look, I don't want to be in a relationship with you Max. Honestly, I'm really not ready for anything like that. I just wanted to grab a drink as friends.

Max nods more than he needs to.

MAX

It's hot in here.

MAGGIE

I guess. The air must be -

Max starts to take off his sweater in a distracting enough way that Maggie stops talking.

He's struggling to get it off. He keeps trying to stop his shirt underneath from coming off, but it keeps getting pulled up with his sweater. It's all very uncomfortable. Then he, accidentally, pulls both of his shirts off.

Beat.

MAX

I need to go to the bathroom.

MAGGIE

Oh.kay.

He grabs his stuff and instead of heading towards the bathroom he heads for the door.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

That's the exit.

MAX

I meant the bathroom at my house.

He leaves shirtless.

MAGGIE

(to self)

Cool....cool. Cool. Cool. Cool

She takes a sip of beer.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

Hm, this is an IPA.

The day counter we've been seeing is now stuck on the screen as the scenes change the counter stays and the day goes up.

CUT TO:

INT. GYM - DAY

Overlay: DAY 16

Maggie is on the treadmill again, right next to Sarah. Maggie's jogging at a pretty good pace and silently singing along to her music. Sarah is blabbing.

SARAH

I mean what is love nowadays? How can you really know if anyone is being truthful?

(MORE)

SARAH (CONT'D)

You know David and I were just talking about our relationship and how it's changed over the years. Maybe you guys didn't talk enough? You didn't, I can tell. Oh my god it was emotional cheating wasn't it?! I knew it!

CUT TO:

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Overlay: DAY 20

Maggie is in the back seat of an uber. She's wearing a cute going out outfit, her make-up is done and her hair is curled. She's looking out the window with her hand on her face and extremely annoyed.

DRIVER

It might not be over.

MAGGIE

It is.

DRIVER

You don't know that for sure.

MAGGIE

I do.

DRIVER

Most loves never end. Did I tell you about my wife and I?

MAGGIE

Yep.

DRIVER

Well, it's worth hearing again. We met in 1978.

CUT TO:

INT. BAR - NIGHT

Overlay: DAY 24

Leslie and John are sitting at a table drinking, in a heated debate.

LESLIE

The joke is about how it's not beef.

JOHN

It doesn't make any sense Leslie. No matter how many times you explain it!

LESLIE

Yes it does! Ugh! Maggie gets it right?

They turn to the empty chair.

LESLIE (CONT'D)

Where's Maggie?

They both scan the room and then see her at the bar. She's chatting with the bartender in a normal way, just ordering a drink.

LESLIE (CONT'D)

Are you fucking kidding me? Are they dating?

JOHN

That's super fucked up.

CUT TO:

INT. APARTMENT - DAY

Overlay: DAY 27

Maggie is cooking in sweats, but looking cute. Her phone is next to her on speaker. She never stops cooking through this exchange.

MOTHER

We always hated him. Your father said from the beginning he would do this to you.

FATHER

And I was right.

MOTHER

He was right! Say it! Say your father was right!

FATHER

Thank God we don't have to see him at Christmas again!

MOTHER

Remember how much gravy he used?

FATHER

There was none left for anyone else.

MOTHER

Do you remember that Maggie?

FATHER

I knew from that day on he was not a good guy.

MOTHER

And he was right! Wasn't he Maggie? Maggie? MAGGIE!

She's distracted by her cooking.

CUT TO:

INT. OFFICE - DAY

Overlay: DAY 30

Maggie is looking very put together and even smiling. She's unwrapping a gift in front of her, as Lucy and Stacey stare at her trying to hold in their excitement.

Maggie is having a bit of trouble getting the box opened. Stacey and Lucy, frustrated this has taken so long, grab it from her and rip it open.

They pull out three shirts and throw one at Maggie

LUCY STACEY

It's our shirts! It's our shirts!

MAGGIE

You actually bought these?

LUCY STACEY

Duh! Duh!

LUCY (CONT'D)

And look, look! On the front they say "Three's a Company".

STACEY

And on the back they say, WRTF!

MAGGIE

What does that stand for?

LUCY

STACEY

We're ready to fuck!

We're ready to fuck!

Maggie's just staring at them in shock.

MAGGIE

You guys work in HR, this can't be appropriate.

Stacey looks upset, Lucy leans into Maggie.

LUCY

Let. Us. Have. This.

MAGGIE

...Ok.

Lucy and Stacy bursts into cheers.

STACEY

Yay!

LUCY

Let's go put them on.

They run out, leaving Maggie staring at her shirt.

MAGGIE

I should probably get a new job.

CUT TO:

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Overlay: DAY 33

Maggie is walking down a street in NYC. She's smiling and listening to her favorite playlist. She looks good, maybe even happy? Her music is all we hear throughout this scene.

She walks past a Panera and glances inside. She sees Max in line. He looks up and sees her. His face immediately drops.

Maggie waves and smiles.

Max begins shaking his head no and backs up, running right into an elderly woman making her drop her purse.

He apologizes profusely, she hits him with her bag, which makes him stumble backward into someone else. He looks up and stares at Maggie.

She mouths "Are you okay?"

He starts laughing crazily and keeps backing up to try to get out of Maggies view. He trips over the "caution wet" sign that was up. He hurts his ankle, grabbing it and then he starts hopping backwards.

Maggie is shaking her head, looking as if she's saying what's wrong with you.

Max hops to the end of the line of people. He gives Maggie a small wave and then faces front. He keeps glancing at her, but is now ignoring that she's there.

MAGGIE

CUT TO:

INT. GYM - DAY

Overlay: Day 35

SARAH

I think everyone should be a vegan. David and I have been vegan for 3 days and I swear it's making our relationship better.

Maggie stops her treadmill, wipes her face, the bars, gets off and walks to the locker rooms. Sarah doesn't even notice.

SARAH (CONT'D)

I think I'm going to write a book about it. I've always thought I could be a writer.

CUT TO:

EXT - SIDEWALK IN FRONT OF A RESTAURANT - NIGHT

The counter fades out.

Maggie, looking put together and happy, is listening to music and walking down a street in the East Village, looking for a restaurant.

BRIAN - the Ex, 20s, handsome, put together, also listening to music - is walking towards her. They run into each other, right in front of an empty host stand in front of a restaurant. They pull out their headphones.

BRIAN

Hey.

MAGGIE

Hey.

They don't know if they should hug or not. So, they sort of just high five and laugh uncomfortably.

BRIAN MAGGIE (CONT'D)

How have you - Oh, sorry. How have you - Oh, sorry.

They both laugh and smile at each other. There's a lot of love between the two.

BRIAN (CONT'D)

You look good Maggie.

MAGGIE

Thanks. So do you Brian.

BRIAN

It's good to see you.

MAGGIE

It is good to see me, isn't it?

They both laugh and stare at each other. You can see that they're sad, but they know breaking up was for the best.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

Well, I should get going.

BRIAN

Right.

They start to awkwardly say goodbye. Then the host walks up to the booth.

HOSTESS

Table for the happy couple?

BRIAN

Oh no.

HOST

What? Don't want to take your pretty girlfriend to a nice dinner?

MAGGIE

We're not together, we broke up.

HOST

Oh, been there last year when my-

Maggie, who has been holding it together, shutting her mouth with Sarah and her friends, just can't hold it in anymore and snaps.

MAGGIE

No. No! I don't want to hear it. I don't care if you also went through a break up 2 years ago or last month or yesterday! I don't care if you took a buzzfeed quiz and it told you, you're a psychic and you were sent here to bring us back together. I don't care if you thought we were great together and are confused as to why we broke up. Because honestly it's none of your business. And you know what?! I'm doing great! Great!

(MORE)

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

She's shaking her head vigorously again at Brian, who's smiling and giving her the thumbs up sign.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

She walks off screen.

The two men just stand there as if they've just been through war. Maggie walks back on screen to the stand.

MAGGIE (CONT'D)

I'm actually meeting someone at this restaurant.

(MORE)

MAGGIE (CONT'D)
So, I'll just go look for them
inside. Great. Great, great,
great, great.

She smiles at both and walks in.
