


music + memory


Big Thief- Spud Infinity

This song is such existential joy for yourself and fellow beings. It fills me with so much joy that I can't help but sing and dance to it.




Rat King, King of Rats- You Ain't the One

I grew up listening to Daft Punk because my dad really liked them. I don't have a good relationship with him now but it's one thing I associate with him that is good...




Ben Platt- Rain


Dexy's Midnight Runners- Come On Eileen
