
Project Statement










First tile-print ->

Why it didn't work:

- Colors were too dark and green
- Bill-block not finished
- Title needed to be bit bigger and moved up
- Actors' names needed to be displayed
- Printer error in the middle of the silhouette needed to be edited





Second tile-print ->

Why it didn't work:

 Specific text in the billblock was too long and breathing space needed to be added





Third tile-print ->

Why it didn't work:

 Billblock was too large and distracting





Strip test and tabloids ->

Why it didn't work:

- Color was too dull on luster and too vibrant on matte (decided to go with luster)
- Title text was too fuzzy
