SUMMARY

- I am Charvel Rappos, a queer and non-binary self-taught artist living and working between Kjipuktuk (Halifax) and Tiohtià:ke (Montreal). For the past decade I have been involved in the DIY (do-it-yourself) and, more recently, the improvisational arts and music community in Kjipuktuk, learning and teaching about art and organization through community building and collaboration, specifically through Radstorm Community Arts Centre, the Creative Music Workshop community, and Wonder'neath Arts Society. I am temporarily residing in Tiohtià:ke so I can explore new groups engaged in collective arts, new opportunities to show my work, and meet other artists who will expand my understanding of art and its place as a potential force in the world.
- My work is focused on the utility of art as a method of questioning and re-imagining reality, a desire developed through work organizing collective spaces and desiring more joyfully painful and fulfilling experiences for my community. From this, my work purposefully stems from a wide range of approaches; illustration and comic art, painting, collective organizing, writing, carpentry, print-making, animation, sign-painting, sculpture, collaboration, textiles, sound-art and beyond; these have together developed a practice that is primarily focused on process flux, mimicry and denial, and striving for the penultimate point of border dissolution, both conceptually and practically.
- I am infatuated with the potential of collective action and the ability to alter circumstance through chance encounters and adaptation in unpredictable environments, and therefore my work attempts to both bring people together and develop their, and my own, ever-morphing identity. To do so, I find myself focused on the edges, confronting ideas of transition, contradiction, scale, form, brand, and iconography, questioning what makes something itself, and therefore answering how it could be anything but.
