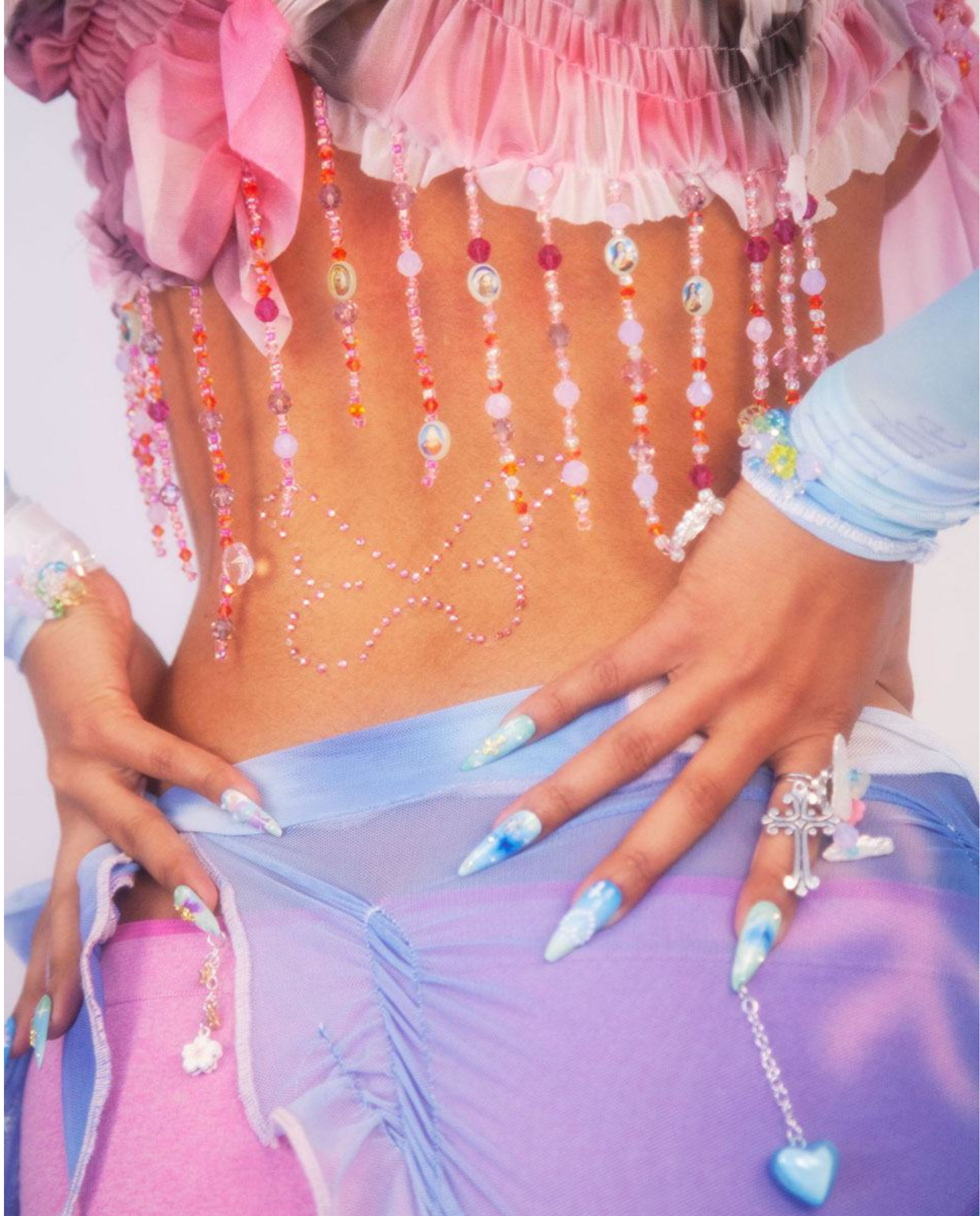
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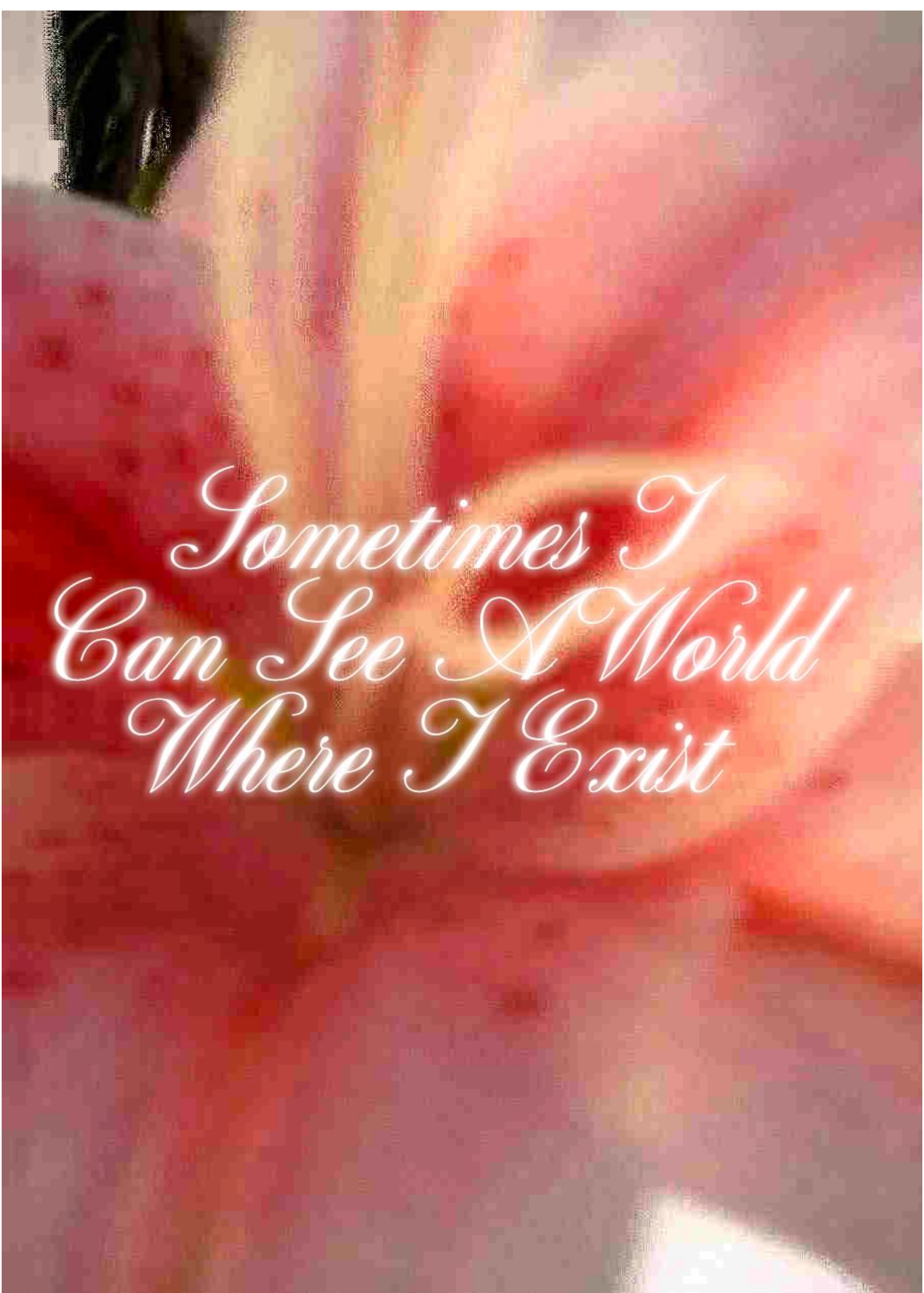

Echo Liu (they/them, formerly Xia Liu) is a queer, nonbinary Chinese-American lens-based artist based in Brooklyn, NY. Working across photography, video, and multimedia, they examine identity, desire, and perception as it intersects with race, gender, sexuality, and class. Through their work, Liu explores how selfhood is constructed and perceived, and what that tension between “reality” and “fantasy” reveals about authenticity and desire. Grounded in lived experience, their practice provokes questions of visibility, intimacy, and the mediated nature of identity in contemporary culture, asking how the lens mediates identity, how perception shapes self-perception, and how bodies can be and are racialized and fetishized. Their work has been featured by Polyester Zine, Refinery29, Aether Magazine, Girlgaze, and Adolescent Content, among others.

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
