

My second exhibition at House of Annetta just closed. It felt very emotional to take my paintings off the walls. I will miss watching the sense of wonder as people step into the house. They'd see the people in my paintings filling the walls, an empty space teeming with people sketched from the street and woven back into narrative paintings, in a house that holds so many unknowable stories of migration within its walls. We talked all day long, unearthing forgotten moments of city life, migration, love & loss, broken cities, the housing crisis, Gaza, war. Wars seek to disconnect. They are wars against the imagination against stories - because stories weave us together, creating dreams and imagination - freedom. Real change comes from from shared stories, from connection. I think Annetta would have loved all the connections that her house contnues to inspire.


