## Jiahao Peng

JiaHao (b. 1994, Wenling City, China) is a Los Angeles-based artist whose work bridges photography, plants, and spatial installation. Trained in photography at the Columbus College of Art and Design, Peng works across living materials and image-making to explore growth, fragility, and impermanence. His practice moves fluidly between stillness and life, between the cultivated and the wild.

In 2022, he founded tenpopo, a studio working with plants and floral design. The name comes from the Japanese word for dandelion — a plant that grows wild, persistent,

and everywhere. Rooted in nature and always changing, tenpopo reflects quiet resilience and everyday beauty. The studio creates plant and flower works that embrace imperfection, celebrate change, and bring a sense of natural calm into living spaces — work that lives between design and spontaneous growth.

Through both his art practice and tenpopo, Peng continues to cultivate spaces that invite observation, stillness, and a deeper connection with the living world.




