





SYNOPSIS

Partition fuses archival footage from the British occupation of Palestine with audio recorded of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon, tracing lines of continuity left by seismic displacement. Recovering Palestinian presence through story, voice and song, unraveling colonial pasts through soundscapes of the precarious present, Partition is a meditation on what bodies remember and empires forget.




DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Silent films gathered in imperial collections hold histories that have barely been told, and ways of colonial seeing that seep into the present. Partition uses dialectical montage and asynchronous sound to examine both. It considers how listening disrupts an overdetermined politics of looking, and the lines of continuity that might be drawn between then and now.


