New members of our association au jus vzw who

- enjoy collaboration and organization—minding that this is often unpaid, demanding work.
- reside in Brussels and be able to commit to a minimum of one year
- · wish to share and actively make and maintain space.
- contribute to the project with new perspectives, skills and ideas.

If your practice is primarily solo or if you are seeking a studio space for individual artistic work, au JUS may not be the best fit.

Note that with this call we aim to increase the representation of FLINTA, BIPOC, crip, and non-European members within our association.

What we offer:

- Space: Members can use our space as a temporary work studio, which includes:
 - Main gallery (40 m²)
 - o Basement level (40 m², divided into two rooms)
 - o Garden area (15 m² outdoor space, still a fictional garden with a lot of potential)
 - o Residency apartment (20 m² short stay, project-related interventions)
- Program: Members can take part in building our program holds space for
 - collective processes and play
 - o queer inclusive practices
 - resident artists and researchers

What we expect:

- Members adhere to the statute of the association
- share responsibility for the rental agreement the space.
- uphold shared ethics about collective work and societal issues.
- participate in rotating roles for administration, event organization, and space maintenance, including the upkeep of the residency apartment.

How to Join:

Our current monthly working costs 1320 Euro per month for the whole three-stories space + running costs for organising at the location at Avenue Jean Volders 24.

We share this cost through our association's members contributions, project funding, donations, space rental and event revenue, whilst maintaining a fair pay policy for artists.

You can decide which role to engage with au JUS, and adjust or define a role to fit your needs:

Statutory Member

Assume a mandate within the association and be responsible for realising the associations' purpose. This implies contributing a variable monthly membership fee according to the association's costs and assuming responsibilty on all levels within the association.

Organising Member

Approximately €100 to 150€ monthly contribution. Includes *Space Access* and *Program Involvement*.

Supporting Member

Approximately 20€ to €80 monthly. Includes free access to public events. By paying more you support Supported Members.

Supported Member

Available when our budget exceeds costs. Includes *Space Access* and *Program Involvement* or free access to public events for persons who are lacking of funds.

Current Members:

While we mainly use English in our collective communication, we also speak other languages: French, Dutch, German, Spanish, and Russian.
