Erick Víquez is a visual artist whose practice is based on the mythopoetic aspects of his own observations of landscape, literature, and art history. His work focuses on the nature of memory and time, using historical and personal archives, popular culture, and literature as resources to bring images back to new meanings through pictorial language. The visual language of his work shows a deep interest in Gothic, colonial, and violent narratives that originate in Latin American history and culture.
