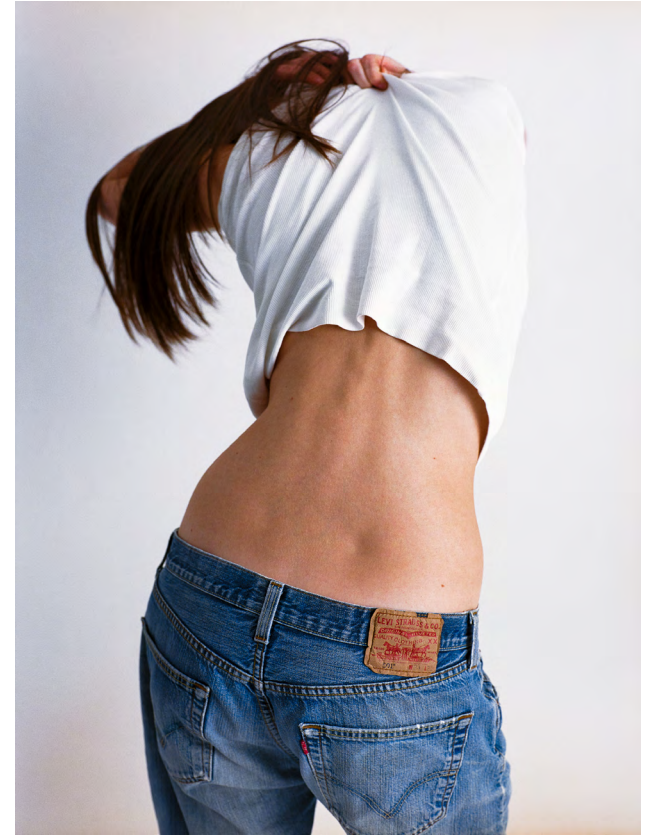

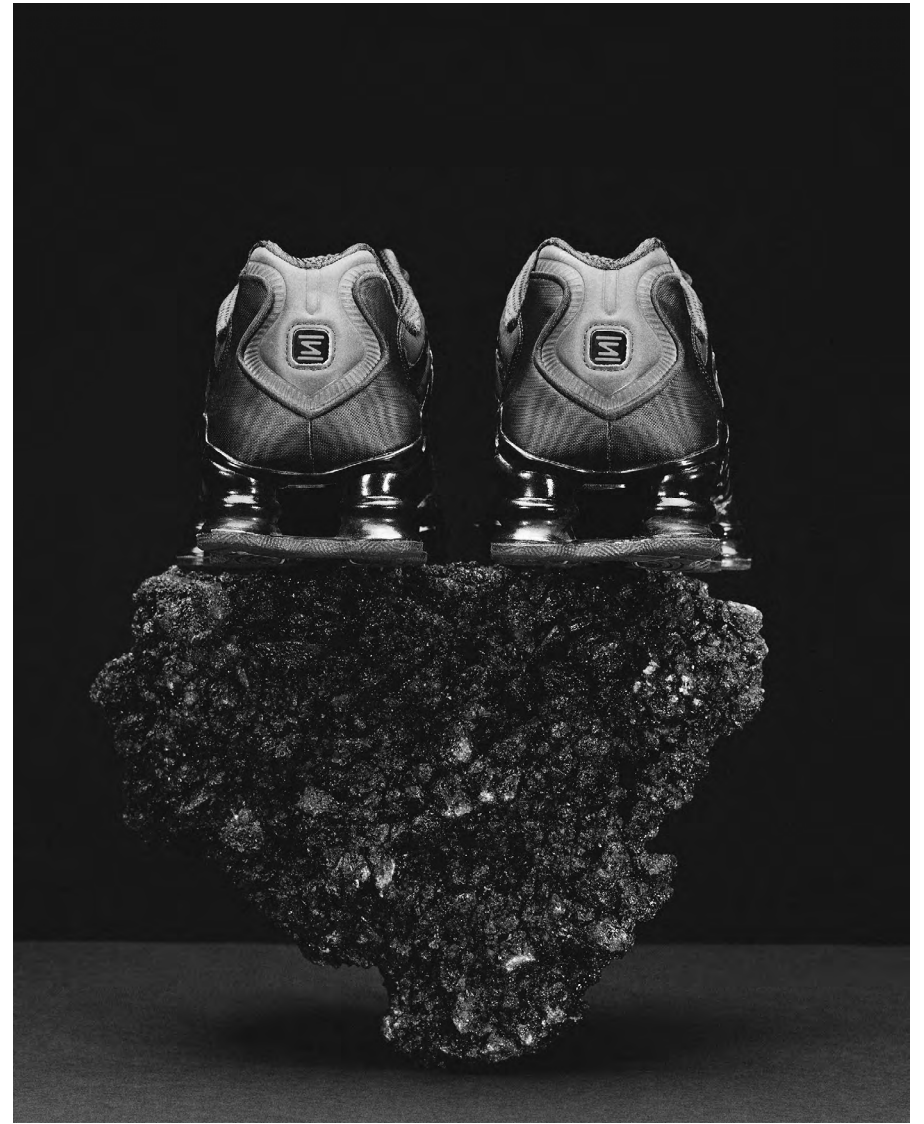




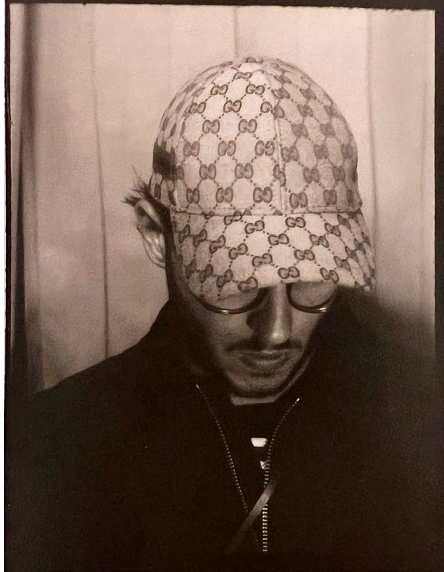

I began my photographic journey through a documentary approach, capturing my friends during skate trips to Paris. These moments were raw, spontaneous, and rooted in everyday life, allowing me to develop an instinctive way of observing people and environments. This work naturally led to the creation of small self-published zines, where sequencing and storytelling became an important part of my practice.

As my experience grew, I moved into event photography, working in contexts such as nightclubs, sports events, and social gatherings. These environments pushed me to work quickly and adapt to changing light, movement, and energy. They strengthened my technical skills while sharpening my ability to capture atmosphere and emotion in fast-paced situations.

More recently, my focus has shifted toward building a fashion photography portfolio. Alongside this, I work with artists to create artist portraits and press kits, blending a more editorial sensibility with my documentary background. My current work explores the balance between authenticity and visual construction, aiming to create images that feel both intentional and human.

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
