Of all of London's public spaces, toilets are among the most neglected. They are a low priority for the government, facing closure by local councils and — aside from "gender critical" feminists — not discussed that much by their users. Toilets are not so loved by the people.

Through our research, we met multiple toilet-loving interviewees who shared their (nerdy) knowledge of the hidden requirements and characteristics of toilets. We hope our findings will help to bring about toilet justice in London.




St. John's Church faces difficulty in making architectural changes. Preservation guidelines protect the church as a cultural heritage asset. Therefore, construction work requires long and difficult application processes. The church has found a way to work around this. Temporary floor boards, detachable carpets and plastic toilet stools have been installed since they do not add "permanent damage" to the building. In doing so, St. John's Church is working to ensure that its future community is an inclusive one.
