

#### The 10 Commandments

- 1. You shall have no other gods before Me.
- 2. You shall not make for yourself a carved image.
- 3. You shall not take the name of the Lord in vain.
- 4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- 5. Honor your father and your mother.
- 6. You shall not murder.
- 7. You shall not commit adultery.
- 8. You shall not steal.
- 9. You shall not bear false witness.
- 10. You shall not covet.

The 10 Commandments

### FOUNDING OF THE MOVEMENT

- Brutal regime led by dictator Idi Amin Dada
- Shambled economy, Ugandan Bush War, enormous uncertainty
- Influence of Catholicism-belief in Marian Apparition.
- Credonia Mwerinde
  - Born in 1952, Kanungu Uganda
  - Engaged in Catholicism (not well behaved)
  - Brewer of Banana Beer
  - Encountered 2 Marian apparition. March, 1981, and June 14, 1989

### EARLY RECRUITS

- Joseph Kibweteere
  - Mid level Ugandan Bureaucrat
  - Failed in his path into politicsretreat to religion
  - Invested in the power of religion to control and influence
  - Had Marian sighting on April 25,
     1984



### EARLY RECRUITS

- Friar Dominic Kataribabo
  - Priest, has loyal followers
  - Value is not found in faith in god but faith in oneself
  - Fancied for a role of Bishop in nearby Cassis diocese, dream shattered
  - Church saw potential usurper in him
  - Wavering in faith

## CON ARTISTRY OF CREDONIA

"Confidence artists...their genius lies in figuring out what, precisely, it is we want, and how they can present themselves as the perfect vehicle for delivering on that desire." (Konnikova, 2016)

- Joseph Kibweteere
  - Confident-failure
  - inwardly insecure and outwardly resentful
  - Center figure in community that craves power
  - Marian apparation

- Friar Dominic Kataribabo
  - Strong faith in himself-failed to become Bishop
  - Wanted to prove to church wrong

### NARRATIVE OF THE MOVEMENT

- Apocalypse is coming because God was enraged in humanity.
- Through restoring the 10 commandment as Virgin Mary said, the Movement was the final chance of salvation.
- Expansion through tight-knit groups of families and villages
- 1993, gained sizable following-Awarded legal status by authority
- Justification for followers to gave up material possession
  - Biblical verse from Old Testament
  - Jesus: leave everything behind and follow me.
- Sieve would end before 2000-Over 5100 deaths


Konnikova, M. (2016)

- Tells the story of Ferdinand Waldo Demara Jr. A infamous imposter and characteristics of con artists-"aristocrats of crime"
- "The confidence game--the con--is an exercise in soft skills. Trust, sympathy, persuasion."
- "Human beings don't like to exist in a state of uncertainty or ambiguity. When something doesn't make sense, we want to supply the missing link."
- Credonia's narrative provided an explanation to the worldly distress
- The Movement as the vessel to heaven-"engrained gullibility"

### CONFIDENCE GAME

Konnikova, M. (2016)

- Dark Triad: Psychopathy, narcissism, and machiavellian
- Psychopathy-previous murder
- Narcissism-Needs to be in the center of attention
- Machiavellian-manipulated others to accomplish one's own objectives
- 3 things: Predisposition, opportunity, and rationale
- Predisposition-Dark triad
- Opportunity-social turmoil
- Rationale-lacking

### WHY DO LIE-CATCHERS FAIL?

Hartwig, M., & Bond Jr, C. F. (2011)

- Previous research: People rely on invalid cues when judging deception.
   Lack of valid cues to deception limits accuracy.
- Through 4 meta analysis:
  - Lie-catchers' intuitive notions about deceptive cues are reasonably accurate.
  - Strongest constraint: lack of valid behavioral indicators of deception
- When deception judgements encounter dark triad:
  - "People are judged to be truthful if they sound immediate, if their face appears pleasant, if they are cooperative and involved, and if their statements seem plausible, realistic, and spontaneous."
  - "Machiavellian-minded people are more convincing liars."

### BORN CON ARTIST?

- "The truth is that real con artists aren't simply born. They are, as is usually the case, made as well...Genes load the gun; the environment pulls the trigger. (Konnikova, 2016)"
- Does this apply to Credonia? What might be the trigger event?
