- 5 East Sussex based artists who are in the first 15 years of their career.
- Artists who want to work within a supportive environment in the Bexhill Creative Quarter to test out new ideas and develop their practice.
- Artists who have experienced barriers in progressing their career.

### What's on offer?

- A 50% subsidised studio at Beeching Road Studios (£125 per month plus VAT).
- Opportunities to participate in Open Studio events at Beeching Road Studios on 10 May and 13 September.
- Mentoring with Flatland Projects Director and Head of Artist Development, and DLWP's Head of Exhibitions and Assistant Curator.
- Support to produce a studio-based project with an identified community group in Bexhill-on-Sea.
- Opportunities to participate in artist development workshops and a group exhibition delivered by Flatland Projects.
