## • Blizzard-Overwatch2 Activewear Program:

Inspired by the characters of the game, we designed a series of sportswear that matches the characteristics of the characters, combining functionality and character skills, and used CLO3D to create virtual costumes for the runway show.

#### • Maggie Sottero-Wedding Dress:

In collaboration with the Los Angeles-based wedding dress brand "Maggie Sottero", I designed a series of high fashion wedding dresses using old wedding dresses provided by the brand, which were disassembled and recut in three dimensions, in order to balance the brand's unique tone with my design style.

#### • Jonathan Cohen-Printing Design:

Based on the brand's "Punk Impressionism" collection, I created a spring resort collection of garments that incorporate my personal prints, showcasing my unique style and creativity.

#### • West Coast Exports-Haute Couture:

Under the direction of designers Vanessa Khattar and Julie De Libran, we created Haute Couture garments with themes of light and the sea, focusing on Haute Couture textures, combining embroidery and other techniques to create unique patterns, and hand-sewing to complete the Haute Couture garments.

### • T-Shirt and Shirt Design Projects:

Created award-winning t-shirts inspired by Christmas, utilizing ruffles and patchwork, and designed innovative shirts using drawstring and deconstructive techniques, earning a clothing design award.
