1990's

Major record labels associated with popular hip-hop acts such as Tommy Boy Records, Def Jam Recordings and Delicious Vinyl began selling branded items embroidered on letterman jackets and workwear jackets.

mid 1990's

Influences included skating and gangster rap. Professional American sports franchises capitalized on this. They had a great impact in the scene. Notably New York Yankees, Los Angeles Raiders, and Chicago Bulls

2000's

The rise of the "bling" culture saw established luxury brands enter the market, with Burberry, Gucci and Fendi appearing in hip-hop videos and films. The most popular shoe of the time was the Nike Air Force 1, immortalized in Nelly's song.

2010's

Complex Magazine named Stüssy, Supreme and A Bathing Ape the best streetwear brands and many subsequently collaborated on acclaimed high-fashion capsule collections such as Supreme x Louis Vuitton.

2020's - future

Streetwear isn't going anywhere anytime soon. High fashion brand names such as Balenciaga are thriving in a world of obscure and useful everyday wear. In the future we will see innovation and new concepts being brought to fruition
