BIO

French multi-disciplinary artist Juliette Suchel explores the intersections and overlaps between image-making and activism, documentary and fictional narratives. This interest developed out of her witnessing and photographing local activist actions in France and the UK. She is currently working with colonial material from her own family's archive in order to re-frame and deconstruct the power and violence such materials otherwise perform. Imaginary cartographies suggest speculative connections between the present and the past

in order to enact practices of reparation, care and togetherness. Juliette is based between the UK and France.
