#### Research

I am an artist-composer who works with other people through sound, moving-image and text. My practice research focuses on theories of non-hierarchical, non-binary relation in cultural studies, sound and filmmaking explored through collaborative projects realised with artists and community groups, using the indeterminacy of *Open Works* as a site for creative investigation into these matters.

I undertake my academic research part-time, to maintain my career as a practicing artist-composer exhibiting internationally in gallery, cinema, theatre and site-specific contexts. I continue to work as a sound designer and mix engineer on artist film, screening across gallery, cinema and television as well as teaching and facilitating workshops in various strands of sound arts and music practices in universities, schools, prisons and community settings.

I do not consider these arms of my practice as discrete, rather each informs processes and learning through the other.
