Mark Dorf is a New York-based artist working across photography, video, digital media, and sculpture. Engaging collaboratively with ecologists and technologists, Dorf's work questions perceptions of what Western culture often terms "Nature". His images and objects examine how design, image culture, technology, and science shape expectations of the "Natural" world, while engaging deeply with the digital processes behind their production. By making the marks of these often hidden digital processes visible, Dorf's work reflects an awareness of its own production, inviting viewers to consider how digital materials shape their own lives and subsequently alter their understanding of the "Natural" world and beyond. Through these inquiries into perception, ecological thought, and digital materiality, Dorf's practice proposes a dynamic, entangled planetary ecology that includes technological systems, and a future in the Anthropocene beyond environmental collapse.
