## Winter Hibernation

Over winter Fran and Aska worked on the fundraising plans for House of Annetta. Anna made amazing diagrams and booklets so we can communicate our ideas. We developed a financial plan for 2030, plus a curriculum for the repair works to make the house warmer and training programme for heritage craft and DIY skills. In March, we visited Basel, where the Stiftung Edith Maryon (organisation which holds the house out of market speculation) is based to present project updates and discuss a plan for 2025 and beyond!

## Repairs

Over winter we carried out some essential maintenance to ensure the ongoing safety of the building. We installed some acrowprops so that the joists and beams are better supported to carry the load of the building. Ash installed a new gate so that the top floor is protected. carefully **Emma** mended the treads of the staircase so they are much less wobbly! In the coming months we will fix some furniture, floorboards, move the bricks which are behind the toilet... And we are currently fundraising for the holistic repairs to take place in 2027!



### Languages of Solidarity
