2. Decide which side will be bound and make a template

1. Measure the side that will be bound
2. Create a strip of paper the same size
3. Draw 4 dots evenly spaced apart (divide the measurement in 5)

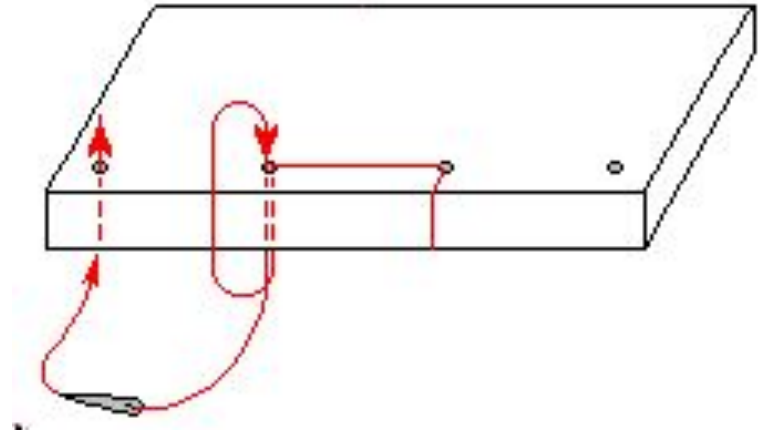
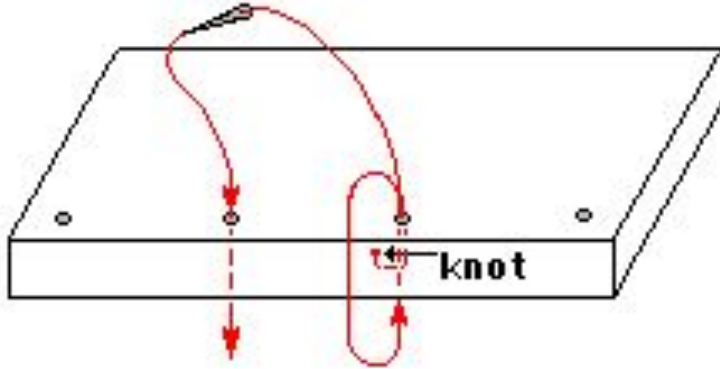


3. Use the template to punch a hole through each page



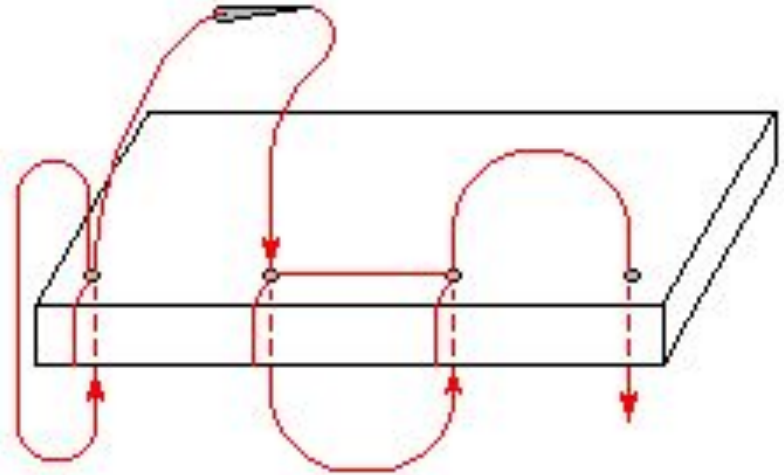
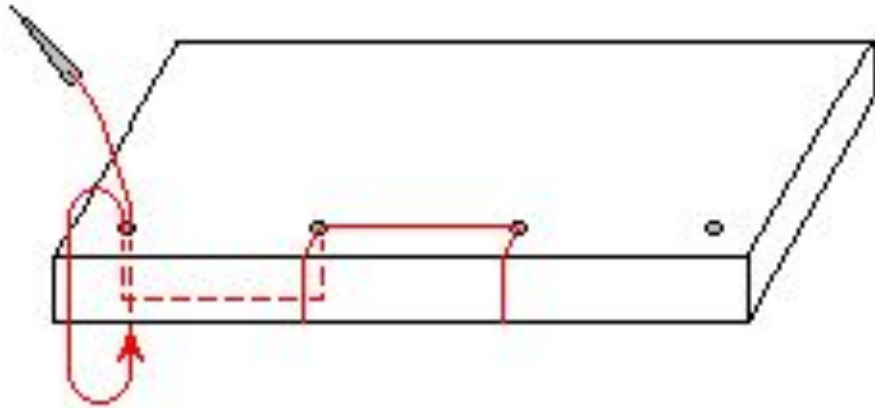
Make sure to line up the template neatly each time so your pages are even

4. Bind your pages



Measure 4 to 5 times the height of your book for your thread
