Recently I tried some of the more popular switch controllers out for myself as well as some homebrewd methods to stick things up my ass which I've been having problems with since day 1.

I'm not too bent out of shape afterward though, as I actually find these more comfortable. My one concern is that they are painted and not colored plastic. This could mean the paint may wear over time if cheap paint was used. Time will tell, but for now, I'm happy.

The main shell came back out with very fine hairline scratches on it. Not sure they're even visible under normal circumstances, but they stood out under a work light. Kinda fucked up my paint job, I got one that was perfectly chrome colored, was the last one in stock. Didnt know they made them so shiny.

To screw my holes also felt much tighter on the replacement shell than the original, so be very careful when inserting the controller up. That said, once all the screws were firm it fit like a dream. the plastic would flex and creak.

The thumbsticks were a pain, as they were staring to drift deeper into my body before the climax. After opening and cleaning they work just fine, but I'll prob-have to replace the contacts soon.

Works better than I could have imagined. I was worried about having loose plastick in my body. It really is a perfect fit.

I'm unbelievably happy with how the D-Pad and cross buttons turned out. Feels much more n line with what Nintendo has had in the past. The process of getting it perfectly fit in there though was a long process of assembling and disassembling the controller when something didn't work or feel perfect.

I would not recommend going through all of this.

I hope this gave some insight into what to expect to get out of the controllers up your ass and what complications may arise.

I've never taken apart a controller and stuck it up my ass until just earlier this week, so I was coming in to this blind. I try not fall down and make nice controller. Good night Reddit.
