Harlequin Pendant Light

HAND PLEATED POLYESTER FABRIC, WOODEN BEADS,
POLISHED STEEL, CRYSTAL GLASS. L/W61 X H54 (CM).



Soft fabric combined with shiny glass, wood and steel create together a textural palette where different materials reflect light in various ways. Harlequin lampshade is hand pleated into a harmonious arrangement that softly diffuses light in a spherical angle, making it easy on the eyes from every direction. Inspired by iconic themes the composition forms an ensemble that celebrates light, shadow and contrasts.

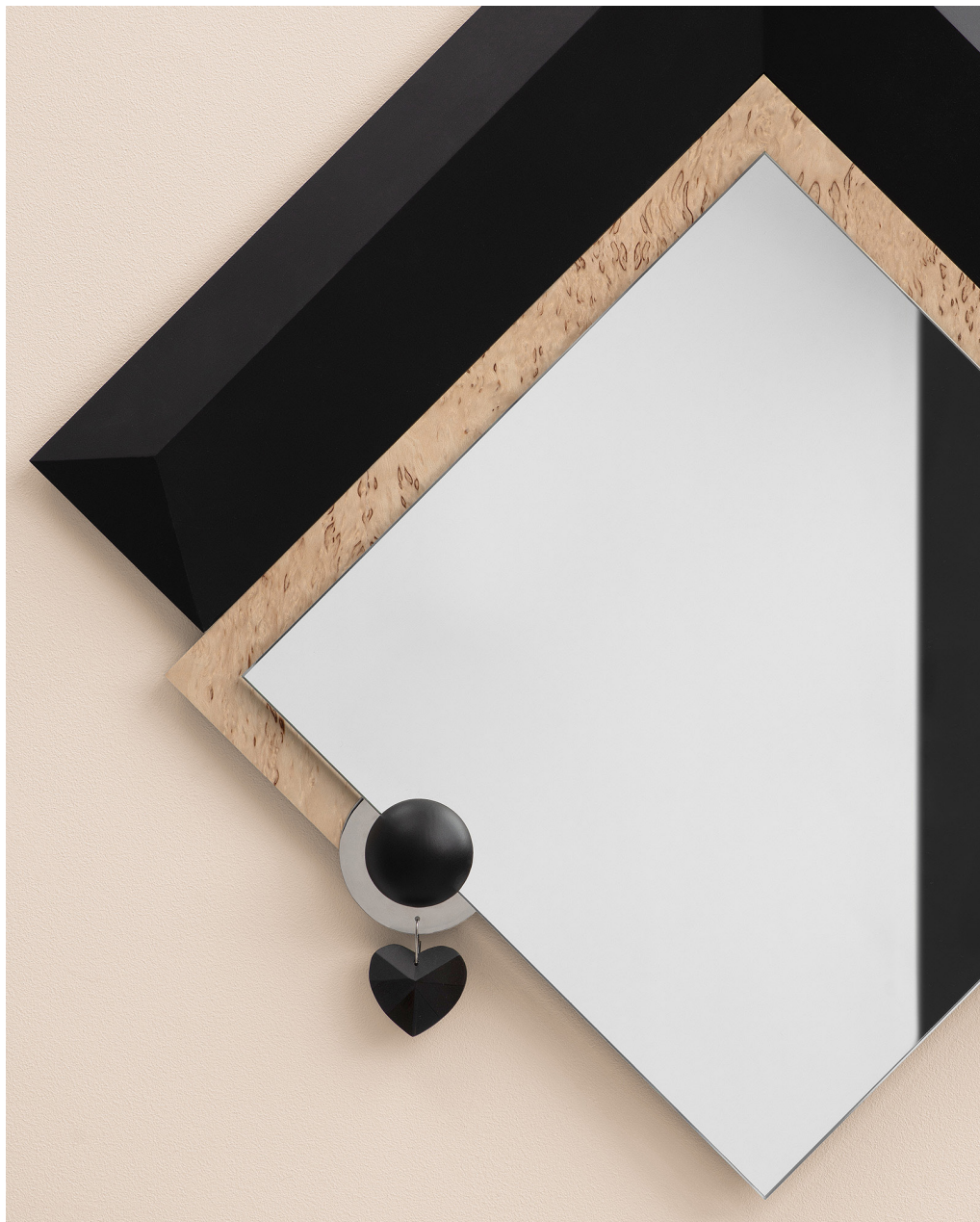


Puro Chair

Puro is a sculptural chair that combines geometrical shapes with poetic silhouettes. The vivid texture of wood is enhanced by the curvy shapes of the chair. The essence of Puro chair is simultaneously exquisite and functional, making it suitable to be displayed as a stand-alone centrepiece as well as a harmonious part of a bigger setting.



Nefertiti Mirror

CURLY BIRCH VENEERED PLYWOOD, MIRROR GLASS, POLISHED STEEL,
CRYSTAL GLASS, PAINTED BIRCH. L49 X H55 X W5 (CM).



A play of basic shapes unites '80s postmodernism, Art Deco and ancient Egyptian styles. Inspired by classic geometry and the silhouettes of legendary Egyptian queens, Nefertiti mirror forms a portal between now and then. Glass, wood and metal create together an expressive palette of structures where different materials represent contrasts and character.



Kaija Table

SOLID BIRCH, BRONZE MIRROR, BIRCH THIN PLYWOOD.
S: L/W40 X H53, M: L/W60 X H40 (CM).



Kaija table is inspired by legendary Finnish designer Kaija Aarikka and the eighties. Round shapes and velvety birch create a tangible essence to the object, making it appealing to approach. The table top is reversible and foldable, with a mirror side adding a spatial feature.



Plankton Light Sculpture

PERFORATED ALUMINIUM, LED TUBE STRING LIGHT.

S: L/H64 x W4, L: L/H 106 x W 6 (CM).



Plankton is a sculptural wall light that creates a dynamic, artistic atmosphere. Turned off the perforated aluminium frame creates a carved artpiece, as the holes forms crisp, dark spots contrasted by the bright surface reflecting its surrounding light. Turned on the black holes transform into light, while the surrounding surface becomes a contrasting dark base.

Elina Ulvio is an award-winning designer based in Helsinki. A background in architecture is inherent in her work, where space and form meet bringing a supplemental dimension to furniture. Her design is described as functional art, adding a unique edge to furniture while providing it with useful features.

Elina works in the fields of product and collectible design. Her work has been featured in publications including AD, Wallpaper, Sight Unseen, Elle Decoration, Vogue Living, Rum and Dezeen, and her collectible designs have been represented by the galleries Oblist, Kolkhoze, Philia, and Bukowskis. Her designs have been exhibited at venues including Design Museum Helsinki, Iittala & Arabia Design Centre, Festival de Cannes, Designmonat Graz, CID au Grand-Hornu, and the Design Weeks of Stockholm, Helsinki, and Milan.
