











falling portraits 2012/2013

ten hour performance in the Moderne Galerie (Saarlandmuseum) during construction, with Malika Hagemann. We played a shuttlecock back and forth with the goal of 1000 uninterrupted hits without it falling to the ground. Everytime the shuttlecock fell down, we started with a new one (we had 1000 at our disposal) and from zero. Our highest number of uninterrupted hits was around 700. veil II — self portraits in the dark 2015 it was pitchblack outside. long-exposre of me covered in a plastic sheet lluminated from inside with a flashlight.






