Using a GDV (Gas Discharge Visualization) device and proprietary technology, the energy during an event is measured and analyzed. Chris Tille, a renowned artist and one of 99 award-winning Blue Chip Artists worldwide, is leading the project. His creative vision and expertise transform the abstract data into fascinating images.

The resulting image serves as a unique memento of the event and embodies the shared mood, motivation and team spirit of the participants. The collective art form serves not only as a memento, but also as an inspirational source to carry forward and reinforce the shared goals and messages of the event.




Procedure:

During the event, measurement cycles are carried out in the background that do not interfere with the process. The collected data is analyzed overnight and presented the next day in the form of a picture. Each participant receives a hand-signed fine art print as a personal memento.

In addition, a large-format picture can be created according to the customer's individual wishes and displayed in the office or in a prominent location as a permanent memento.

TeamSphere offers participants an intense artistic experience and a lasting memory of the collective spirit and the inspiring combination of science and art.

Chris Tille works at the intersection of science and art. Trained as a classical photographer in Innsbruck, Austria, he now uses photography, installation and sculpture as a means of visualizing complex data sets to make scientific principles and discoveries more accessible and meaningful.

His series use data from a variety of research fields as a starting point, which he then interprets, remixes as different sensory experiences and meticulously reconstructs to make the information accessible to the public again in mostly larger-than-life objects and works.
