L&NDLESS is an interdisciplinary arts research collective co-founded by Devika Bilimoria, Luna Mrozik-Gawler and Nithya Iyer in 2017, creating live audio-visual durational performances.

GEOFADE began in 2020 as an ongoing research collaboration between Devika Bilimoria and Luna Mrozik Gawler, centred on queer(y)ing time. GEOFADE works alongside queer earthscapes and time scales beyond the human to retune to the slow pace of planetary histories and futures, through labs, workshops, installations and extended site relationships.
