




SYNOPSIS

Exhausted from being the epicenter of conversations, Ramona takes a visit to the hair salon were she makes an impulsive decision. A decision that she believes will finally free her from the burden associated with her striking red hair.



DIRECTORS NOTE

For as long as I can remember I have always recorded my life on video. During my preadolescente years, I recreated movies and videos that led me to find my identity. This was the early 2000s, a time when several USA production companies began to create films that showed the typical life of an american teenager. The great impact of films like Clueless, Mean Girls and Virgin Suicides showed the urgency for cinema that spoke about these experiences.

Today the films of my adolescence are still vibrante and are watched by many young people of the new generation. They are time machines that connect us with our adolescente being that is discovering herself and often does not like what she sees in the mirror.

However, by only reflecting the reality of a USA adolescence, there is a certain need for some content in our Latin American language. THE GOLDEN LASHES is a short film that takes us precisely to this place where my latin american teenager lives and is trapped under a large mane of red hair.

DIRECTOR




Sara García Osorio Director

Graduated from New York University with a degree in Liberal Studies focused on Creative Production and Contemporary Culture.

Since her return to Colombia in 2019, Sara has worked in the production area of different films. She was a Key Set in the feature film Horizonte by César Acevedo (in post-production), Memento Mori by Fernando López (FICCI, 2023), and Mi Bestia by Camila Beltrán (ACID Cannes, 2024). Sara has also worked as a script supervisor in the short films Binomios by Vicente González (FICCI, 2023) Liebres by Laura Carvajal (Feratum Mexico, 2023) and as second assistant director in the short film Todo Incluido by Duván Duque (TIFF, 2022). In 2022 she participated in the International Meisner Technique Workshop for Directors and Actors with Professor Stephen Bayly at the San Antonio de Los Baños International Film School.


Although this is her first project as a director, Sara has been working on "home videos" made with a handycam for several years on Instagram under the name "Se Ve Una Mierda." This project has allowed Sara to create a constant relationship with video, taking steps towards experimentation with image, editing, and the possibility of telling stories with memories recorded in simple formats. In November 2023 she presented several of these projects in her first film essay exhibition called Creative Processes at La Yunta Casa Cultural in Bogota, Colombia.

PRODUCER




Ana Winograd

Starting in 2019 she assumed the roll of producer and line production of several audiovisual projects, among which there are several short films, feature films, commercials, music videos and web series. In 2021, she joined Evidencia Films, alongside the producer Franco Lolli. Within the framework of the company, she served as production director of different short films such as LA PERRA by Carla Melo (Cannes, 2023) ALL INCLUSIVE by Duván Duque (TIFF, 2022), and the feature film EL OTRO HIJO by Juan Sebastián Quebrada, (San Sebastian, 2023). Currently, she is the Line Producer of the new feature film by Los Niños Films Todos Mis Viajes Son Viajes de Regreso, directed by Manuel Ponce de León.

She has recently ventured into directing video clips and short documentaries motivated and inspired by the role of women in horror and suspense themes. Co-founder of La Cueva Films (2019-2023) and producer of audiovisual and transmedia projects that focus on themes of social and cultural interest.

With around 6 years of experience in the industry, Diego has made music videos as a director for artists from international and independent labels such as El Freaky, Juanes & Alfredo Gutierrez, El Kalvo (BOGMVF Selection), El Débil for w.y.k, winner of the scholarship project for creation of music video for IDARTES (2020) (Seleccion SINCRO, Pioneer Town Film Festival, USA). His most recent music video Immune - N.Hardem ft.Edson Velandia was a finalist in the Latin American competition of the mfv of Brazil.

Most of his career has been in the Art Department. Among his works as a production designer, the following works stand out: Más Allá de la Noche (FID Mareseille 2021) by director Manuel Ponce de León and the feature film Todos Mis Viajes Son Viajes de Regreso (Winner of the FDC Ficción 2023). Apart from his career with the production company Los Niños Films, he has held different positions in the art department in national and international feature films, music videos and advertising campaigns with production companies such as AG Studios, Wi-deangle Films, Jaguarbite, Lunatic, among others.

She has published a collection of poems, Corte invisible (2022), and other poems in fanzines and anthologies. Sara makes experimental music, as a soloist and in a group. In her work she likes to explore the powers and fragilities of the voice and its relationship with the body and writing. She has performed on various stages in Bogotá and Mexico, and has toured in Chile and Argentina. Sara has a solo album on vinyl, Surcos y Cimas.
