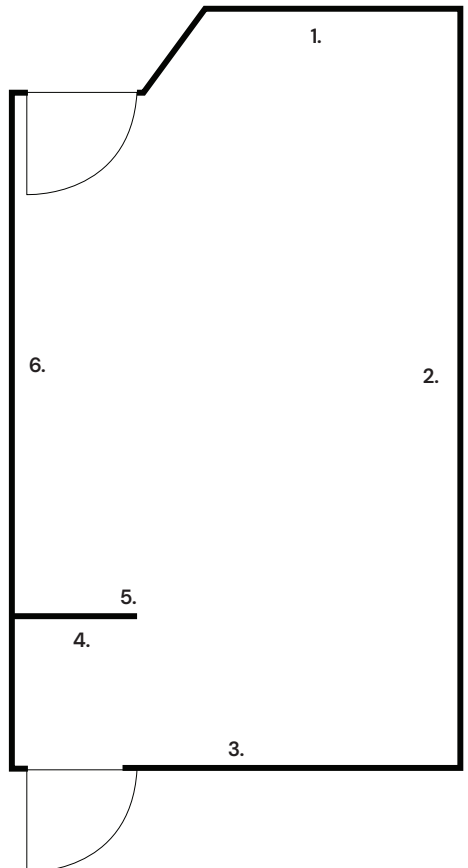


Paul Halton and

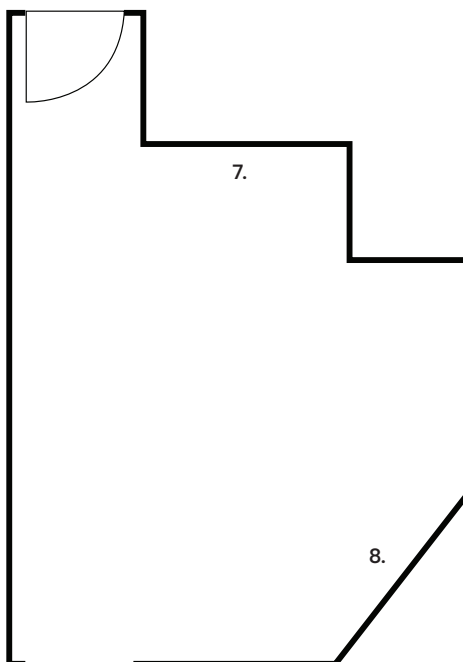
