

“The masak masak show”

theme: Food

Venue: art session conducted in the lab,
for installation to be placed indoors/
outdoor.

Idea:

i have always enjoy to “cook” when i was a kid, doing all the actions like how a chef will do, and creating my self-invented dishes. This installation is simply inspired by my favourite childhood activity, till now, i have make drawings out of these actions, especially while i am making collages.

Execution

Children will use different forms of paper to make their dishes, they will create everything from paper.

cutting,stripping, drawing and coloring on paper, chopping. they will “make believe”.

A cooking stand will be provided, an apron and chef hat will be given while they are creating their dishes, at the end of the session, all the dishes will be glued and mounted on to a plate. all the “dishes” will be mounted on a wall as an installation.

I will prepare all the materials, different forms/colors of papers all in containers

5 woks play-stations will be set up.



Tentatively,

50 dishes are to be created for the wall installation.

10 art sessions to be created in 3 days.

1.5hrs each

Hope to register for children participant before each session.

2 days to glue and install all the works.

Materials needed

-5 woks ,cutlery, chopping boards, scissors, tapes, assorted papers, containers, plates, white glue, hole-makers, coloring materials, aprons and hats.
