#### Bio

Francisco Menezes (b. 1993) is a multidisciplinary artist based in Lisbon, Portugal. He holds a degree in sculpture from the Faculty of Fine Arts of Lisbon and attended the Maumaus Independent Study Programme. Selected exhibitions in the past include the Paula Rego Prize at CHPR (2017, 2018), Essays on Collaboration at Pousio, Lovers, and Our Slice of Time at Zaratan (2022), and Casa da Dona Laura (2023) among others. He collaborates with ArteCapital since 2024.

Focusing on photography and installation practices his work is widely informed by Byung-Chul Han's notion of the object as a counter-body. The word 'object' comes from the Latin verb 'obicere', which means to 'throw at', 'put towards' or 'reproach'. Hence the object is primarily an Against, something that turns against me, throws itself at me, opposes me, contradicts me and offers resistance. It's this notion of the counter-body that interests him and the sum of objects being more than its mere accumulation inscribed in a space between the delocalized and the hyperlocalized.
