The test is complete, it scores you along two scales (scores are between one and five):

• Your score for **avoidance** was 1.4. this personality trait is related to how much you are unwilling to allow yourself to be vulnerable to your partner. High scorers do not like to open up to others. Low scorers share their feelings freely.
