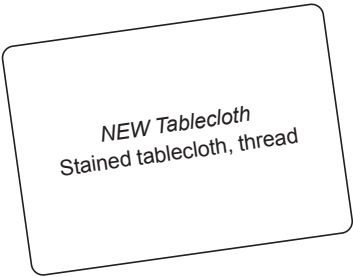




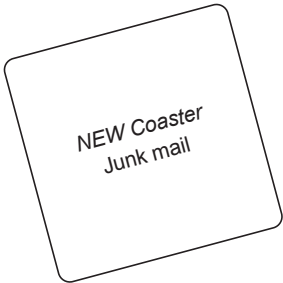
*NEW Tablecloth* and *NEW Dish Towel* utilize existing blemish patterns to create bespoke, one-of-a-kind textiles. Noticeably stained and worn areas have been removed, and the resulting negative space is embraced as a design element. Slightly less surface area, more photo opps.



*NEW Cushion* is a seat cushion filled with a plastic bubble mailer. Lightweight and economical, the density of mailers can be customized to personal preference and the cover removed for washing and spot cleaning. Simply replace the cushion insert(s) as needed. The addition of a colored elastic loop makes for an easy carrying handle or hanging device.



*NEW Coaster* re-forms the stack of junk mail on the table into a more intentional accumulation of paper—now with the added benefit of protection against watermarks.



*NEW Vessel* elevates the ubiquitous plastic bag to the realm of art and design. Glistening, graphic and distorted, these materials become objects of desire without breaking the bank.



*NEW Ground* takes the plastic scrap waste that settles on sidewalks and gutters and re-situates it in a permanent location. The scattering of colors creates an unlikely mosaic that doubles as the perfect backdrop for your patio furniture.



*NEW Bag* transforms various plastic packaging into bags suitable for a multitude of tasks. Whether a pocket-sized container for snacks, or a large reusable shopper, these bags are always there when you need them.



*NEW Garden Hose* is a garden statue made from damaged garden hose. Reshaped into a taller, sleeker form, the hose reclaims its place in the garden—a sculptural element all along.
