She resides on a working farm where she raises sheep for wool and runs a fiber studio dedicated to her love for animals and the ancient art of felt making. She owns and operates an e-commerce business called Love Lamb NY, where she sells felted fleece from her beloved flock of sheep.

Jess is sought after by interior designers and has been commissioned to produce works for both private residencies as well as hotels - most recently Wild Flower Farms, Auberge Resorts Collection. She is a recipient of the 2024 Rural & Traditional Arts Fellowship via New York State Council on the Arts.

A strong, self-taught, one-woman show, Jess is inspired by nature and celebrates wool as a fiber with both a rich history and infinite potential.
