Maria Ezcurra (she/elle/ella) is a Latina-Canadian artist, educator and mother living in Tio'tia:ke/Mooniyang/Montréal. She has presented her artwork on numerous occasions in Canada, USA, Europe, Latin America and Mexico. She has also developed diverse public, participatory and community art projects in various contexts, and is a founding member of the *Intervals* art collective. She is the recipient of the *Prix de la diversité en arts visuels* from the Conseil des arts de Montréal (2019), the *Prix Powerhouse* from La Centrale galerie (2022), the *Prix en Art Actuel* du MNBAQ (2023) and the *Prix Charles-Biddle* (2024). Ezcurra holds a PhD in Art Education from Concordia University and is currently a course lecturer at McGill University. Being a double immigrant, her artwork explores notions of memory, identity, belonging and immigration, and the cultural power of personal and social objects, mostly clothing.
