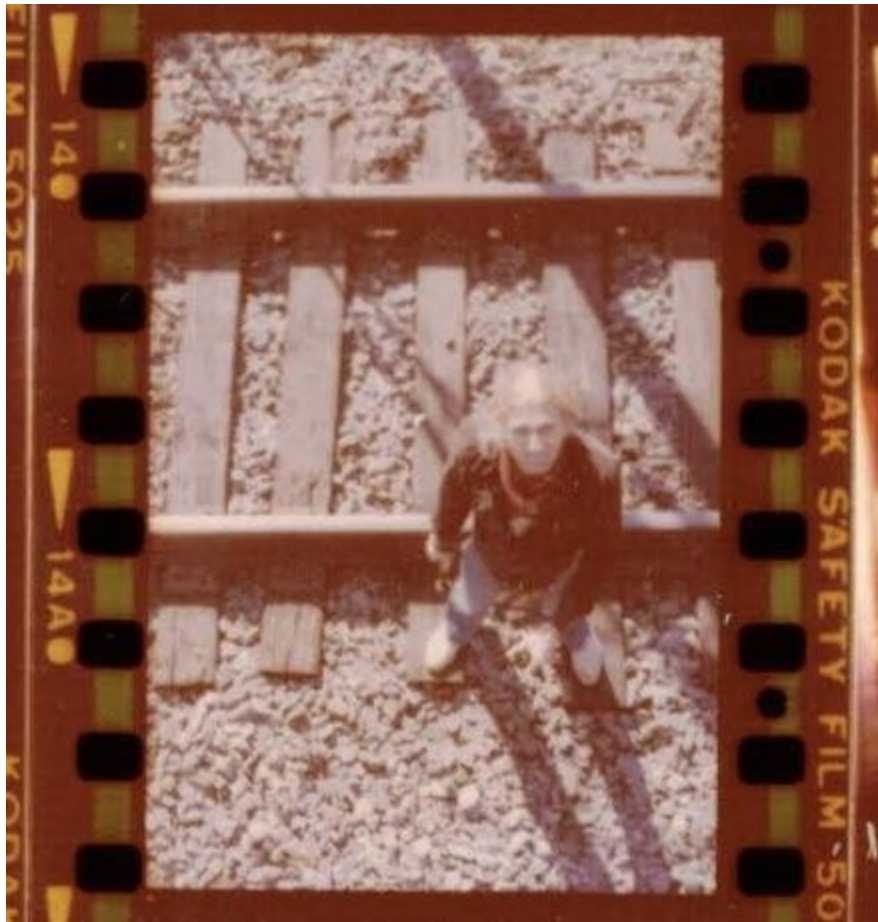

With great sorrow we mourn the loss of (Mike) Walter Robinson, an artist and writer who had his finger on the pulse of the creative spirit and depth of talent present in Lower Manhattan early on. His literary skills developed when he and Edit D'Ak created the underground arts magazine *Art-Rite*, giving the art world a unique perspective into what mattered downtown.
