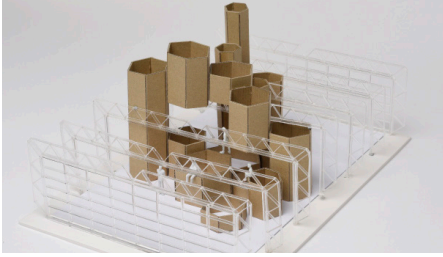


HANNA INEZ-MARIA LINDGREN
