Douville presents a series of seven found image works, attributing meaning and value through their re-contextualization. Pulling on images from the past, the work can be conceptualized as a time-machine, informed by mysticism and the artist's Haitian heritage.

Anbachal nét is the gallery's first exhibition in Paris France. Aligned with Art Basel Paris, U-Haul Gallery will extend its presence in Europe.

Caroline Douville is a Canadian-Haitian artist living and working in Berlin, Germany. Douville's work explores modern conceptions of identity in diaspora communities, highlighting the unique role that the internet plays in the construction of personal and familial histories.
