



2020 was meant to be the most organized year in our history. We planned every detail further in advance than ever before... and it was working! Then in mid-March, while presenting at a crowded conference, myself and the other attendees were instructed to avoid shaking hands with each other. Within days, if not hours, we found ourselves in a different world.

In April, we issued a new kind of programming calendar: Art City at Home, prompts and ideas for art projects people could create while in quarantine, and delivered supplies to those who needed them. Simultaneously, we promoted *We Made It!*, a forthcoming exhibit of artwork made during this time. To be honest, I thought We Made It! would happen by June, but by then, we were carefully returning to in-person engagement with a Covid-proof answer to our annual parade, a virtual video shoot. This led to the greatest summer of all: Art City Outside, the triumphant return of everything we love: Art, community, and each other! In September, we transitioned to Art City Outside After School, and in October, moved indoors to spacious Sherbrook Flats.

When Manitoba hit "Code Red" in November, we rallied once again and came out swinging with Art City Curbside, a menu of free art kits complete with instructions and supplies designed and packed by the entire Art City staff team.

We learned a lot about ourselves in 2020, and are happy to have contributed something right to a year that was so wrong!

Art City's Community Programs had many iterations during 2020. It began with weekly programming at partnering sites and free art workshops at places and events like the WAG, Festival du Voyageur, and the Forks. Then in March, like everyone, we abruptly halted all inperson programming. For the most part, we stayed connected to the participants in our outreach programming by altering how we engaged with them each week. Art City Community Programs provided three types of art experiences during the pandemic: weekly art kit delivery, virtual workshops, and—briefly—outdoor programs.

We created and delivered weekly art kits for participants who would have attended our regular outreach programs around Winnipeg. A silver lining to this approach is that an extraordinary number of people have been able to build their own "home studios" with these supplies, giving them the means to make art on their own for many more hours that we could possibly provide in a drop-in setting. Another branch of outreach has been virtual, as both pre-recorded "how-to" videos and live video workshops with group interaction. Lastly, some outdoor, socially distanced art was able to happen last summer/fall around the community.

Altogether, our community programming provided over 4,150 unique art experiences in 2020. It has been a time of tremendous activity and drive to stay connected to our community. It is an understatement to say that I feel proud of our team.
