Hundreds and thousands of us have now been taking to the street for over a year, calling for our government to represent it's people - to call for a ceasefire, to halt the supply of all arms to Israel and they do not listen. We need to find other ways to channel our grief and our solidarity. Palesinian and lebanese citizens are calling for a global general strike that has the power to exert pressure and disrupt the flow of capital. In the UK our work (taxes) have paid for almost half of the 1,600 surveillance flights over Gaza in 2023, more than Israel	(20 per cent) and the US (33 per cent), according to analysis of open source data by Al Jazeera. Unions, particularly transport and logistics are being requested to strike throughout November.
