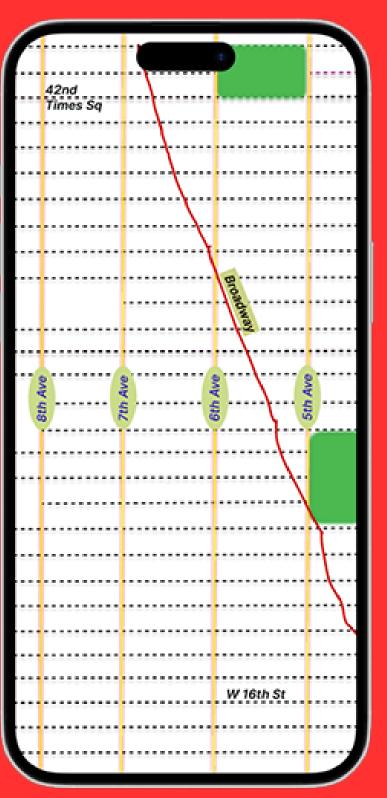

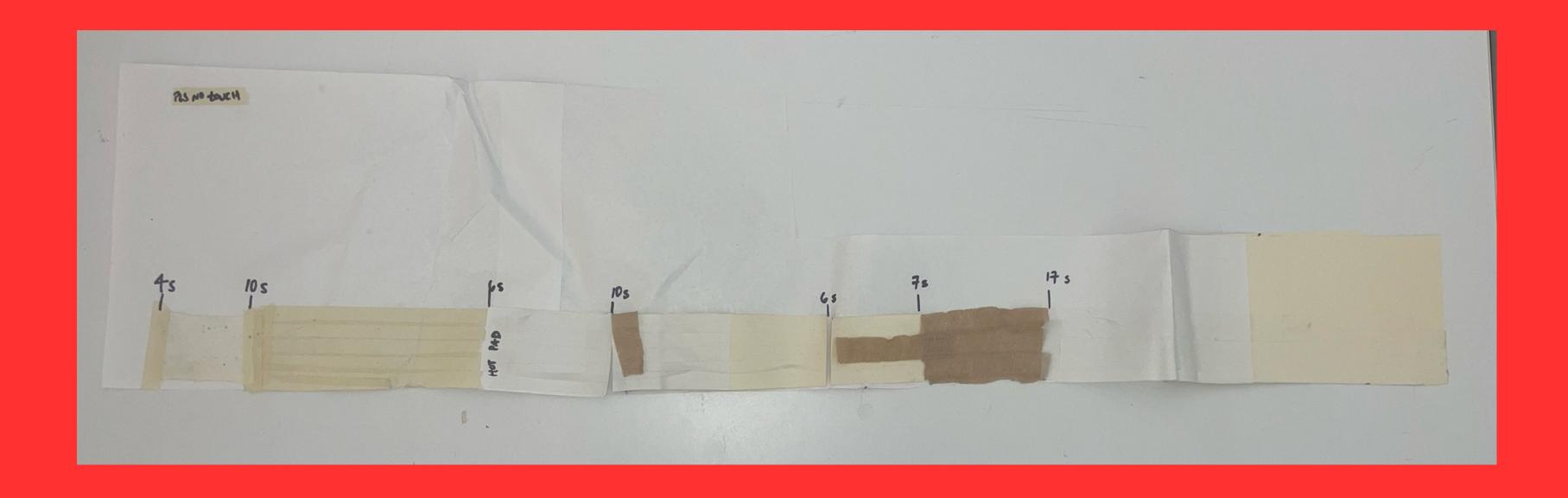

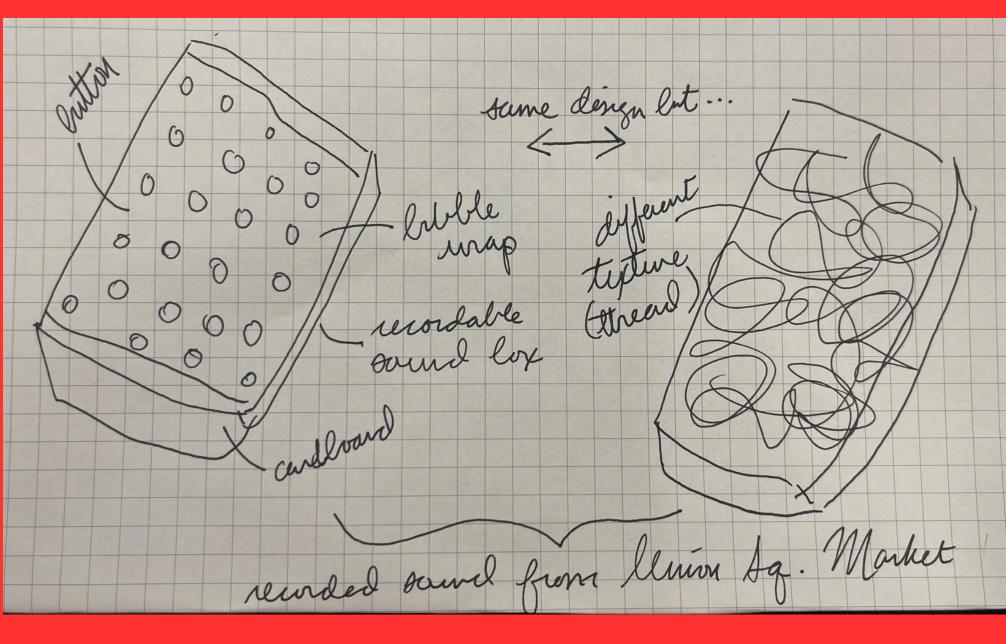


2. PAPER PROTOTYPE
