

Erin Cluley Gallery: Ten Years August 24 – September 28, 2024

Erin Cluley Gallery is pleased to announce a group exhibition, *Erin Cluley Gallery: Ten Years*, commemorating the gallery's ten-year anniversary. Bringing together new works by current and past exhibited artists, *Erin Cluley Gallery: Ten Years* reflects on the gallery's history and presence in the Dallas Fort-Worth art community. The exhibition will span both gallery locations, Erin Cluley Gallery and Cluley Projects, highlighting both spaces' contributions. A diverse schedule of public programming will support the exhibition, honoring the regional community and its invaluable contributions to the visual arts.

In 2014, Erin Cluley Gallery moved into its first space at 414 Fabrication Street in West Dallas. After a five-year tenure as Director of Exhibitions at Dallas Contemporary, Erin Cluley brought a community-first mindset to the commercial gallery model. On Fabrication Street, the gallery featured a diverse roster of artists and collaborators igniting a creative movement and acting as a hub for visual arts and community engagement.



After five years on Fabrication Street, Erin Cluley Gallery moved to the Riverbend development in the Design District of Dallas. The gallery's expanded roster brought together emerging, mid-career, and established artists from Dallas, the United States, and internationally. For its inaugural show at 150 Manufacturing Street, Erin Cluley Gallery featured exhibitions by Korean light artist Chul Hyun-Ahn and Dallas-based sculptor Catherine MacMahon. At its new location, the gallery has continued to present provocative exhibitions from artists working in both traditional and alternative forms including painting, sculpture, new media, photography, sculptural installation, and public intervention.

In 2021, Cluley returned to West Dallas opening a satellite location dedicated to emerging Texas-based artists; adjacent to artist studios and galleries in the Tin District, Cluley Projects brought Cluley close to Dallas' burgeoning West Dallas art scene. This incubator space introduced new opportunities to Texas artists through regular programming and an annual open call. In its tenure, Cluley Projects has shown many regional artists emphasizing Erin Cluley Gallery's ongoing commitment to community-engagement in the arts.

Encompassing two gallery spaces, Erin Cluley Gallery and Cluley Projects, the group exhibition celebrates a decade of contributions and collaborations with artists, curators, and community members. Bookending a decade in business, *Erin Cluley Gallery: Ten Years* celebrates the gallery's continuing commitment to the future of visual arts in Dallas.
