At Photo Fair Unseen in Amsterdam my work will be on show at 2 different locations.



At the 'Gashouder' I have a duo exhibition in booth 22 of Janknegt Gallery together with the amazing work of Dutch photographer Lynne Leegte.



This year I was selected to show my work at 'Unbound', a sensory exhibition in the 700 m2 industrial heritage Transformatiehuis hall. Unbound is dedicated to exploring the expanding outer limits of the photographic universe on a monumental scale, and Unseen's most ambitious project to date.



I created an installation as part of my ongoing project 'Thought Trails', consisting of a 10 meters wide double-layered triptych and a few very tall vertical voiles hanging from the ceiling. All with photographic landscapes with lots of details like hand embroidery. Visitors are invited to walk through the installation, immerse themselves in it and let their thoughts flow.

Unseen takes place from 20 - 22 September at the Westergasterrein in Amsterdam.

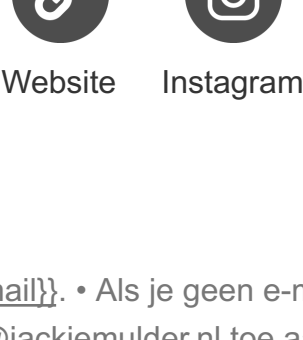
