Mateo Ruiz González

Bio

Mateo Ruiz Gonzalez is a lens-based artist from Bogotá, Colombia, currently based in Brooklyn, New York. He holds a B.F.A. in Fine Arts from the Universidad de Buenos Aires in Argentina. Through an exploration of cultural beliefs—both fact and myth—his practice, often divided between personal and documentary work, examines human behavior and its emotional connection to a specific place or the idea of one, as well as how time continuously reshapes the relationship between the two.

Mateo was recently selected to participate in the 2025 Trespasser Workshop in Marfa, Texas, taking place in early summer, and received a merit-based scholarship to join the ICP Creative Practices one-year program starting this fall. He will also be an artist-in-residence at the Elf School of Arts in North Carolina next September. In 2024, Mateo was named the Magnum Foundation NYC Work-Study Fellow and received the Creators Lab Photo Fund grant, organized by Aperture and Google. He was awarded a merit-based scholarship from the Penumbra Foundation to attend their Long-Term Program. In 2023, he completed an artist residency at Yaddo in Saratoga Springs, New York, was a fellow of the En Foco Inc Fellowship Program, and earned a special mention in the Silver Eye Center Fellowship.

Mateo's 2021 project, *Chilluns' Croon*, earned several honors including recognition from the Aperture Portfolio Prize, OD Photo Prize, Verzasca Foto Festival, NYFA Fellowship Program, Photo Collective Australia International Prize, Urbanautica Institute Awards, and The British Journal of Photography. In 2021. He was a City Artist Corps grantee for NYFA and an artist-in-residence at Eyes on Main Street in North Carolina. In 2020 he was invited as a grantee to participate in the COVID-19 Writers Project (C19WP), an initiative by The Pulitzer Center and National Geographic. Some of this work was also featured in *2020: A Year in Photos* by The Pulitzer Center and included in *Inside the Curve*, a traveling exhibition by National Geographic.
