make something that others respond to as well.

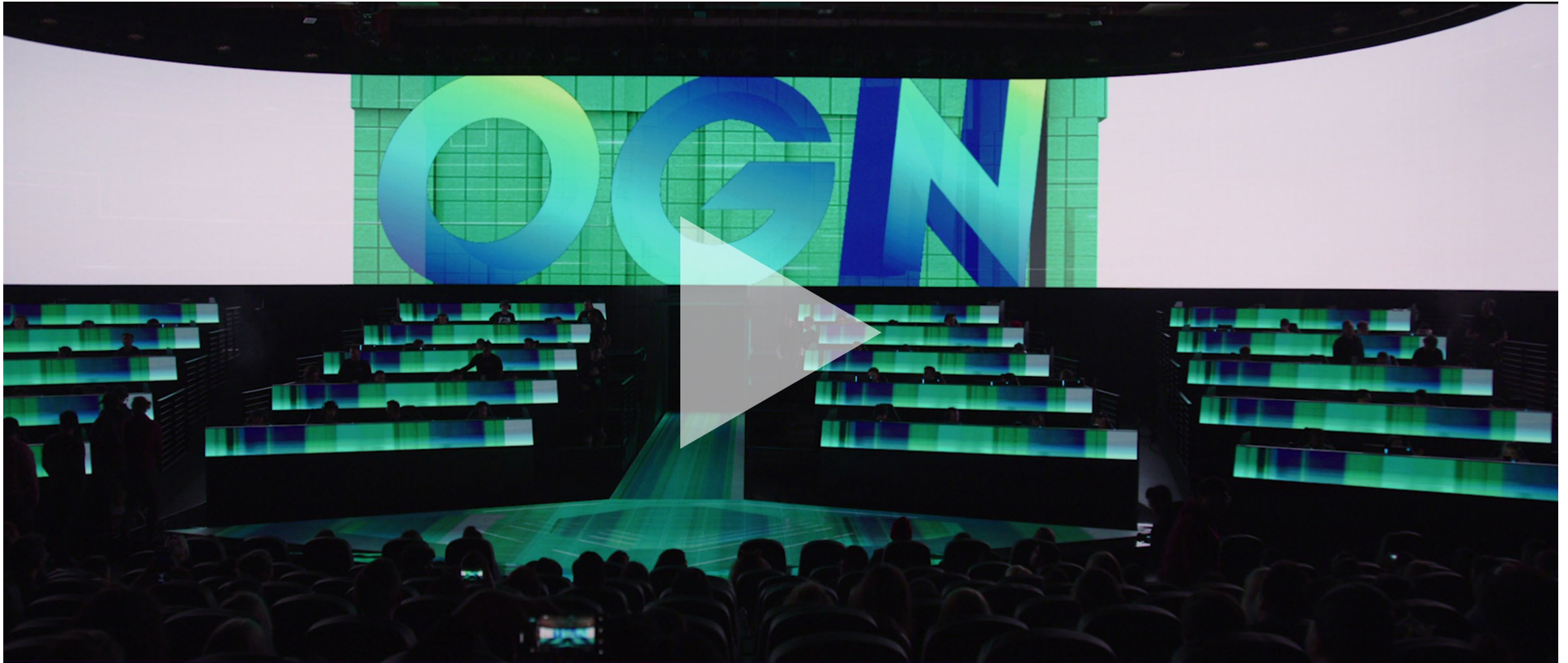

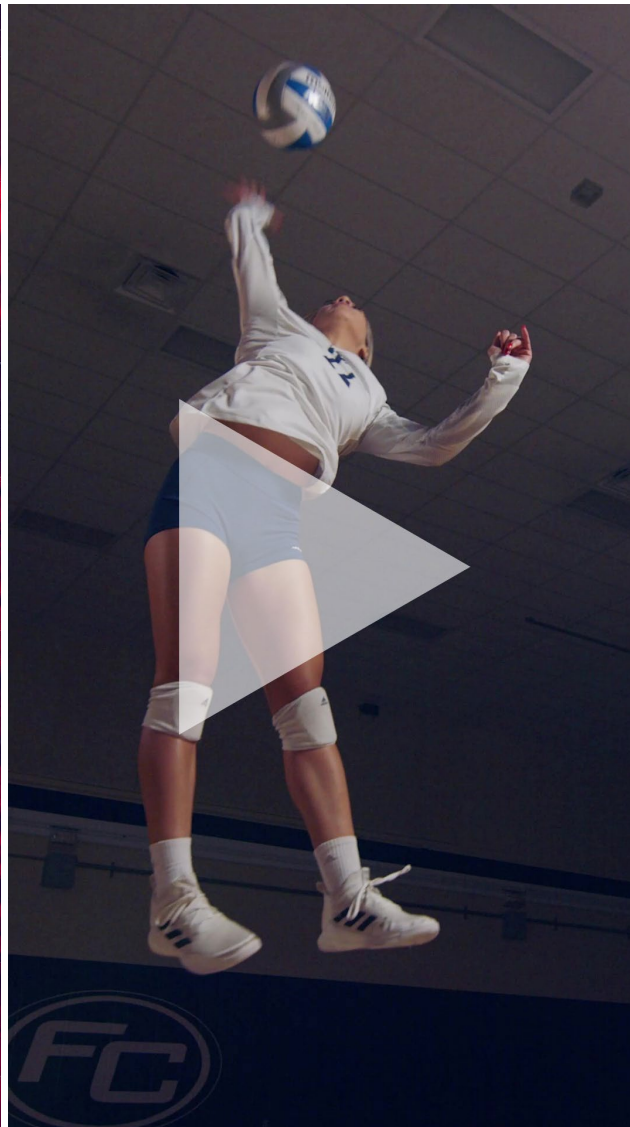
