The color choice was also a story Orange is optimism and energy Attention grabbing! The gain i got is the journey behind the master piece










When ab pitched the idea, I had a genuine feeling and excitement about the project and the core idea of it.


This was a wonderful opportunity to bring different talents together and enjoy the versatility of this puffer piece.

We playfully experimented with it, creating different personas, almost superheroes dressed in the fashionable now.















I always try to push design culture and innovate and working with a team with the same visions only brings hope and optimism for the future of Saudi fashion, we are just getting started.










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

The experience was stressfully amazing.


