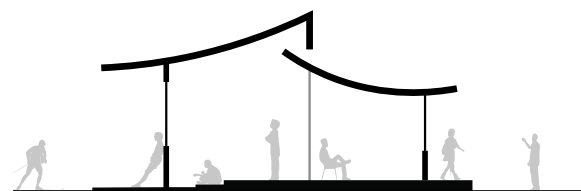


OVERLAPPING CRATERS



Inspired by the craters of the Krafla and the movement of the Breiðamerkurjökull glacial tongues, the cabin is a testament to capturing the landscapes of the Icelandic region. The heart of the design lies the concept of intersection, where the roof of the cabin intersects with the silhouette of the Krafla Crater. This shear overlap creates openings for the southern part of the building, allowing ample natural light, thus providing a scenic experience. The play of the roof angles

blurs the boundaries of the landscape, extending the nature of the environment.

The cabin is designed with both visitors and ski enthusiasts in mind. The cabin features two main entrances for easy access equipment tuning areas, and inviting interiors with panoramic windows framing the picturesque scenery.
