







An interactive performance and social happening at the art academy in Bergen The 'SALON6' project is an interactive NAIL ART GALLERY, where students can come to the nail saloon and have tiny nail art made on their nails, like in a real nail saloon.

Dear Artist

Cheers from the art academy in Bergen, more specifically master students Line Poulsen & Mia Robsahm. We are currently establishing an interactive performative piece called SALON6 and reaching out to artists we look up to and are inspired by.

SALON6 is a surprise pop-up nail saloon we will open at our academy.

We ourselves act as owners, curators and nail technicians in SALON6.

In the nail saloon we will give out free manicures, and each manicure will present 6 works of art. For us, this is an opportunity to take care of our fellow students and artists. A gesture to honour artists work, and pamper one of their main tools; their hands.

We are inspired and fascinated by nail art, and the discussion of what can be art. We want to celebrate the tiny, live and temporary art.

The nails are a cute location for a non-white cube gallery, and one of the great things we imagine, is all the conversations it can start everywhere it travels.

With great respect for professional nail artists and nail technicians, we want to pay homage to them by this project. Also, we want to challenge the view of what can be part of the art world.

We want to merge the world of nail art with the world of fine art. Our hope is that this saloon can be the beginning of a supportive art community, both in the saloon, but also when the art moves around in the world.

We curate a selection of artists we want to exhibit at our first SALON6 group show. We would love for you to be part of it. So we humbly ask you if we can include the attached artwork of yours?

Details:


Your artwork (painting, photo) or a picture of your artwork (performance, sculpture, intervention) will be printet as a sticker for us to be able to stick it to a nail. We will have a catalogue where the client can see your artwork in a larger scale, with your info (artistname, title, production year, dimentions, materials). The technique we use is gel polish, which is a strong UV-hardened polish that make the manicure last for 2-3 weeks.
